

Where the process begins:

- Your Local unit or employer notifies
 OTIP when you are absent from work for
 11 to 20 consecutive days or more (based on your plan).
- 2. A Member of the Early Intervention Team contacts you by phone to:
 - provide you with information about the program
 - determine how to best meet your individual needs

OTIP Early Intervention

Is a confidential support program offered to you at no cost through your LTD insurance plan. Services offered through this El program often help to prevent, or shorten, the duration of disability claims.

How the program works

The focus of this service is to evaluate your needs in the early stages of a medically related absence from work.

Once your situation has been assessed, your El Rehabilitation Consultant will provide individualized assistance and support when required, to help facilitate your recovery.

This early intervention focus provides an extra level of advocacy and support for our members.
