

Parent Communication with Coaches 2025 - 2026

Spark Volleyball Club has a **48-hour cooling off period** policy. Parents are prohibited from initiating communication with any Spark Coach, Club Director or Board Member regarding coaching decisions until **48-hours after the conclusion of a tournament**.

Any display by a parent that reflects upon the club in a negative manner may result in a \$100.00 fine assessed by the club. The fine will be due to the club before the player's next scheduled practice/tournament. The player will be prevented from participating in future club activities until the fine has been paid. Further outbursts may result in the parent(s) being banned from practice and tournaments.

Conflict resolution that takes place outside of the public eye can help prevent uncomfortable situations and better enable the players, parents and coaches to have an enjoyable season.

The following is the prescribed conflict resolution path:

- Work directly with the coach
- If the issue cannot be resolved with coach, contact Club Director.

We also ask parents to refrain from coaching players from the sidelines and advising coaches on how to coach. Experienced, quality coaches have been hired for each Spark team.
