NT:59 agorazo (ag-or-ad'-zo); properly, to go to market, i.e. (by implication) to purchase; specially, to redeem: KJV - buy, redeem.

THAYER'S GREEK LEXICON

NT:58 agora—1) to frequent the marketplace, 2) to buy in the marketplace, 3) figuratively, Christ is said to have purchased his disciples, made them as it were His private property. 4) He is also said to have bought them for God by the shedding of His Blood. 5) They are spoken of as purchased, withdrawn from the earth

NT:1805 exagorazo (ex-ag-or-ad'-zo); from NT:1537 and NT:59; to buy up, i.e. ransom; figuratively, to rescue from loss (improve opportunity):

NT:1805 Exagorazo to redeem a) by payment of a price to recover from the power of another, to ransom, to buy off b) metaphorically, used of Christ freeing the elect from the dominion of the Mosaic Law at the price of his vicarious death 2) to buy up, to buy up for oneself
