**Titus 3:5** Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; 6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; KJV

### STRONG'S

NT:3824 paliggenesia (pal-ing-ghen-es-ee'-ah); from NT:3825 and NT:1078; (spiritual) rebirth (the state or the act), i.e. (figuratively) spiritual renovation; specifically, Messianic restoration

### THAYER'S

NT:3824 paliggenesia--new birth, reproduction, renewal, recreation, regeneration a) hence renovation, regeneration, the production of a new life consecrated to God, a radical change of mind for the better. The word is often used to denote the respristine state, its renovation, as a renewal or restoration of life after death

b) the renovation of the earth after the deluge

c) the renewal of the world to take place after its destruction by fire (as the Stoics taught)

d) the signal and glorious change of all things (in heaven and earth) for the better, that restoration of the primal

## WEBSTER'S 1828

**Renew:** To renovate, to restore to a former state, or to a good state, after decay or depravation; to rebuild; to repair.

Renewed the altar of the Lord 2 Chron. 15.

To re-establish; to confirm

To make again.

To begin again

To make new/ to make fresh or vigorous; as, to renew youth; to renew strength; to renew the face of the earth Ps. 103/Is 40. Ps. 104

In theology, to make new; to renovate.

**Renewable:** That may be renewed; as a lease renewable at pleasure.

**Renewal;** The act of renewing; the act of forming anew; as the renewal of a treaty.

**Renovate:** To renew or restore to first state.

**Restore:** To return to a person, as a specific thing which he has lost, or which has been taken from him and unjustly detained. We restore lost or stolen goods to the owner.

To store again, the goods taken our were restored.

To bring back or recover from lapse, degeneracy, declension or ruin to it's former state.
