1 Corinthians 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; **2** By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. **3** For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; **4** And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures: **5** And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: **KJV**

STRONG'S

NT:2098 euaggelion (yoo-ang-ghel'-ee-on); from the same as NT:2097; a good message, i.e. the gospel: **KJV - gospel. GOOD NEWS!**

THAYER'S

NT:2098 euaggelion--1) a reward for (bringing) good news **2)** good tidings **a)** the glad tidings of the kingdom of God soon to be set up, and subsequently also of Jesus the Messiah, the founder of this kingdom. After the death of Christ, the term comprises also the preaching concerning Jesus Christ as having suffered death on the cross to procure eternal salvation for the people in the kingdom of God, **b)** the glad tidings of salvation through Christ **c)** the proclamation of the grace of God manifest and pledged in Christ **d)** the gospel **e)** as the messianic rank of Jesus was proved by his words, his deeds, and his death, the narrative of the sayings, deeds, and death of Jesus Christ came to be called the gospel or glad tiding

“The Message of the Cross”

Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: **KJV**

1 Corinthians 1:17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. **18** For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. **KJV**

Repent and Believe the Gospel

Mark 1:14 Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: **repent ye, and believe the gospel. KJV**

1 Cor 1:23 But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; **KJV**

“PERVERSION OF THE GOSPEL”

Galatians 1:6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto **another gospel: 7** Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would **pervert the gospel of Christ. KJV**

“THE GOOD NEWS”

Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: **6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: **7** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: **8** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
