1. **Salvation – Soteria**
 rescue, safety, deliverance, preservation, defend, health
 rescue from the molestation of enemies, saving from the
 spiritual consequences of sin, *saved*
Past, Present & future Salvation
2. **Redemption – Agorazo**
 to ransom, to release, buy off, purchase, bought with a price,
 market or thoroughfare, recover, liberate, rescue from loss
3. **Grace – Charis**
 A benefit, favor, divine influence, a gift from God, pleasure,
 kindness, a grant, goodwill, sympathy, liberality
4. **Faith – Pistis**
 trust, assurance, persuasion, hope, conviction, credence,
 confidence, belief, reliance, the substance of things hoped for
 the evidence of things not seen
5. **Justification – Dik-ah-yoo-o**
 to declare one to be just, to pronounce righteous, acquittal, to
 make or declare worthy, to judge or deem righteous,
 exonerated, vindicated, to pronounce not guilty
6. **Righteous – Dik-ah-yoo-sune**
 equitable, just, holiness, freedom from sin, sanctity, virtue,
 honesty, equity of character, purity, right wise ness,
 truthfulness, innocence, correctness in thinking feeling and
 acting
7. **True Worshippers – Proskunetes**
 to kiss toward, an adorer, to prostrate oneself in homage, to do
 reverence, deep respect, obeisance, to venerate, genuflect,
 honor, admiration, awe, great love,

 True – faithful, constant, sincere, accurate,
8. **Forbearance – Anochē**
 self restraint, tolerance, punishment delayed, long suffering,
 holding back, to hinder, patience, enduring,
 to repress
9. **Propitiation – Hilasterion**
 An expiator, an appeasing, sacrifice of atonement, placation,
 pacifying, conciliate, to satisfy

10. Repent – Metanoia

Reconsider, feel differently, reconsider, to change ones mind,
to contrite over, feel sorry, Godly sorrow, to regret, to feel pain

Conversion – Epistrepho

To turn to, to reform, revert; convert, reversal, to transform,
Turn around, change destination

11. Imputation – Logizomai

To take inventory, to count, righteousness credited, to estimate,
account, compute, credit, ascribe, to reckon, to esteem, to
throw on

12. Reconciliation – Katallage

To make an enemy a friend, to remove all enmity, to be
restored to favor, to harmony, friendship, to settle, restoration
of men to God by his Grace, exchange

13. Predestination – Proorizo

To predestinate, to mark out a path, to decide beforehand, to
foreordain, to appoint beforehand, to decree beforehand, to
limit in advance

14. Adoption – huiiothesia

Son ship, the placing as a son, to place, from slavery to son
ship, to make a stranger an heir, those led by the Spirit of God
are the Son's of God

15. Glorification – Doxazo

To praise, extol, magnify, elevate, celebrate, honor, ascribe
splendor, to esteem, render glorious, or lustrous

16. Sanctification – Hagiasmos

To make holy, set apart unto God, to purify, consecrate, to
make sacred, hallowed, to make free from sin, to be made
perfectly pure, morally blameless, to dedicate to God

17. Forgiveness – Af-ee-ay-mee

To remit, completely cancelled, to lay aside, forsake, to send
away, let go, give up a debt, removal of an offence, to bestow
unconditional favor, to omit,

18. Regeneration – Paligenesia

Spiritual renovation, born again, genesis, born anew
spiritually, restoration, rebirth, reestablish God's favor,
renewal

19. Crucifix – Stauroo

**A stake, a post, figuratively to expose to death, a cross, a beam,
an instrument of torture, a pole,**

20. Resurrection – Anastasis

**Rising, raising up, restored to life, to cause to stand, recovery,
rising from the dead, raised to life again**

21. The Gospel – Euangelion

**The good news concerning the death burial and resurrection of
Jesus Christ, the Power of God unto salvation, good tidings,
the message of salvation, the joyful message**

22. Preaching – Kerugma

**An announcement, a proclamation, heralding openly, shouting
from the roof tops, to publish a message**
