South Shore Association's Environmental Education Assistance Program

The South Shore Association is pleased to make available this award to graduation High School seniors entering the following fields of study ¹:

Environmental Engineering Geology
Environmental Science Forestry
Marine Biology Water Resources

Wildlife Management

Other environmental fields of study will be considered provided they support the conservation mission and goals of the South Shore Association and its membership.

Any applicant must be registered as a full-time student carrying a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester; preferably at a college located in New York State. Applicants may pursue either an associate or bachelor's degree in their chosen field of study.

Applicants from the following school districts which border Oneida Lake will be given preference:

Camden Canastota Central Square Chittenango Cicero-North Syracuse

Awards will be made each semester after the recipient provides documentation of continued studies. Awards will be in amounts up to \$1,500 per year for either two (2) or four (4) year programs depending on the degree pursued. No award will exceed this amount regardless of the circumstances. However, a two (2) year award may be extended to a four (4) year award should the recipient receive an Associate's degree with a good academic record followed by the pursuit of an acceptable field of study in a Bachelor's Degree program. Please note:

Applications are due by April 15. If awarded, the applicant must fill out a renewal request form and provide a transcript each semester. Any student that withdraws or leaves college for any reason will forfeit all future allotments. Failure of the recipient and/or college to provide evidence of satisfactory completion from the previous semester's work, as certification of eligibility for the following semester(s), will result in the delay of payment until such documentation is received.

- 1. A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION.
- 2. THE ATTACHED APPLICATION AND COVER LETTER MUST BE POSTMARKED BY APRIL 15TH.
