The Wolf Township Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman, William DeWire at the Township Building. After the Pledge of Allegiance roll call was taken and a quorum was declared. Supervisors attending were Bill DeWire, Dean Barto and Charlie Hall. NEW BUSINESS:


