

Wolf Township Supervisors – Regular Meeting – June 13, 2016

The Wolf Township Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman, William DeWire at the Township Building. Roll call was taken and a quorum was declared. Supervisors attending were Bill DeWire, Dean Barto and Charlie Hall. J. Michael Wiley-Solicitor and Melanie McCoy-Secretary/Treasurer attended the meeting.

Visitors: Rick Marsh

Minutes: A MOTION was made by Dean Barto and seconded by Charlie Hall to approve the minutes from the Public Hearing and Regular Meeting held May 9, 2016. Motion approved.

REPORTS OF OFFICIALS AND COMMITTEES

Code Enforcement: Monthly report distributed to the Board.

Planning Commission: The PC recommended approval of the Richard Michael 4 lot Subdivision. The plan was reviewed and approved by the County Planning Commission and Todd Pysher. A MOTION was made by Dean Barto, seconded by Charlie Hall to approve the plan. Motion carried.

Solicitor:

A MOTION to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement Ordinance #2016-03 was made by Dean Barto, seconded by Charlie Hall. The agreement is with Hughesville Borough for police protection at the Ashkar School property in Wolf Township. Motion carried.

Mr. Wiley was instructed to write to Mr. Harry White to remind him that enforcement action will be taken if he does not apply for the appropriate permits and hearings to conduct his business at his property.

The Township received a request through their engineer, Dan Vassallo, asking if the inlets for Chel Drive could be fabricated. Mr. Vassallo will remind Mr. Thomas that the letter with conditions for inlet approval needs to be signed and returned before moving forward.

Roadmaster: First round of mowing has been completed. The Township mowed along Race Street which will be paved by Hughesville Borough. The Road Department is waiting to hear from their contractor on a start date for the improvements to Pine Tree Rd.

Secretary/Treasurer: A Conditional Use Hearing for Justin Gardner is scheduled for June 28th, 7pm. Mr. Gardner contacted the Attorney General's Office of the Commonwealth to review his case. Mr. Wiley has a call into the AG. A letter will be sent if no word is received.

Sewer Authority Report: Rick Marsh reported that the East Side of the MIRA Point project has been completed and the Authority has signed off on it. Last Friday, the plant had some issues with a foam overflow. DEP was notified and the problem contained and solved.

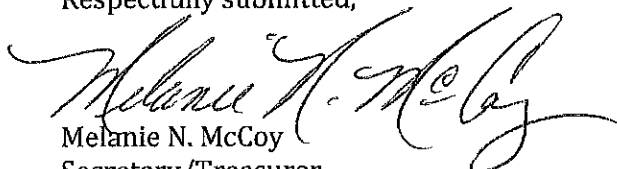
Daversa Corporation, a subcontractor for Comcast, has notified the Township that they may need to do a road cut to replace a line at 54 Richard Ave.
