5. A MOTION was made by David Thomas, seconded by Gregg Clayton to approve Resolution 2022-03 Designation of American Rescue Funds for Paving of the Municipal Building Parking Lot, bid through the West Branch COG, bid was awarded to HRI Inc. in the amount of \$31,567.60. Motion Carried.
6. Laurel Run Bridge: 2 options- replace the bridge with a new box culvert or repair the bridge. Suggested to get price comparisons in the two options.

Sewer Authority Report:

The Main pump is completed, and DEP gave the stamp of approval. People are starting to pay off back payments.

Water Authority Report:

Bill Edner reported that bids are out for the tank for on Reservoir Rd. Creek bank along pump station was completed and they are still at a stand still with the Blue Sky project. Also discussing getting water to the Moose Lodge.
