Minutes: A **MOTION** was made by David Thomas, seconded by Gregg Clayton to approve the Regular Meeting minutes held on May 10, 2021. Motion Carried.

REPORTS OF OFFICIALS AND COMMITTEES

Code Enforcement: Monthly report distributed to the Board.

Planning Commission:

A MOTION was made by David Thomas and Seconded by Gregg Clayton to not require TRACS- K&M Tire Warehouse to provide screening along the mobile home park. Motion Carried.

A MOTION was made by David Thomas Seconded by Gregg Clayton to conditionally approve TRACS-K&M Tire Warehouse. With the following conditions: Improvement Guarantee/ Stormwater Maintenance Agreement, and Bond. Motion Carried.

A MOTION was made by David Thomas and Seconded by Gregg Clayton to approve the Stormwater Maintenance agreement for Lycoming County Department of Public Safety 911 Communications Tower. Motion Carried.

Solicitor

Roadmaster:

David Thomas made a **MOTION**, seconded by Gregg Clayton to accept the COG bids for Seal Coating (Russell Standard Corporation)-\$116,859.19, Paving (Hawbaker)- \$84,262.40, and Line Painting (Midatlantic Marking)-\$4,240.80. Motion carried.

Larson Design Group completed their annual inspections of bridges throughout the Township. Larson Design recommended the repair of 2 bridges. T-145 Laurel Run Road and T-157 Baker Hill Rd. Mr. Brungard from Larson Design Group will be working with Gregg to repair the bridges.

A **MOTION** was made by David Thomas Seconded by Gregg Clayton to rent the Boom Mower for the Month of October in the amount of \$6,900.00 from Stevenson Equipment. Motion Carried.

Sewer Authority Report:

Richard Marsh notified board that all the part for the main pump have been ordered through Costars. The Sewer authority also rejected the request that they take over Muncy Creek sewer lines.

Water Authority Report:

Bill Edner reported that the Authority still has finalized documents with the Department of Public Safety on the Communications Tower. They are also progressing in the Blue-Sky Project.

Application for the American Rescue Plan Act was completed June 7, 2021. Wolf Township is expected to receive \$319,659.78. Half is to be distributed by July 2021 and the other have by July 2022.
