

Wolf Township Supervisors – Regular Meeting – October 11, 2021

The Wolf Township Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Dean Barto, Vice-Chairman, David Thomas at the Township Building. Supervisor attending was Gregg Clayton. Jennifer Mausteller-Secretary attended the meeting.

Visitors: *Bill Edner- Water Authority, Richard Marsh- Sewer Authority, Daniel Vassallo & Bill Brown*

Mr. Vassallo presented the board with a 5-lot subdivision. With 4 access driveways onto Lime Bluff Rd. Supervisors suggested it be brought in front of Planning Commission.

Water Authority Report:

Bill Edner reported they have received the site development plans for the 911 tower, and they are awaiting the start date from Hawbaker's to repair the creek bank.
