The Wolf Township Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman, Dean Barto at the Township Building. The supervisors who attended were David Thomas & Gregg Clayton. Scott Williams- Solicitor, and Jennifer Mausteller, Secretary, attended the meeting.

Visitors: *David Brown, Steve Little, Virginia Feigles-Kaar, Ed Feigles – LCPC, and Chris Hodges.*

Steve Little- Would like the supervisors to uphold the original decision on the MOU for the Kim Estates.

David Brown- Would also like the Supervisors to handle the stormwater and land development of the Kim Estates.

Minutes: A MOTION was made by David Thomas, seconded by Gregg Clayton to approve the Regular Meeting minutes February 9, 2026. Motion Carried.

Solicitor

1. A discussion was held regarding the MOU for the Kim Estates. The MOU that was received from the County Solicitor Michael Wiley has no changes from the original that the Township previously denied. Ed Feigles from Lycoming County Planning expressed they would like the MOU in place to eliminate duplication on the review of the Kim estate plans. It was expressed that the Hughesville Borough might want to have the Township handle everything. The

Township Solicitor is going to rewrite the MOU adjusting the responsibilities to the Township and will address with the Borough council.

Roadmaster:

1. A Motion was made by Gregg Clayton, seconded by David Thomas for the purchase of a new Ford F600 Truck, in the amount of \$71,560.00 from Sunbury Motors. Motion carried.
2. A Motion was made by David Thomas, seconded by Gregg Clayton to purchase the upfitting on the new Ford F600 Truck in the amount of \$52,636.22 from BRADCO. Motion Carried.
3. A Motion was made by Gregg Clayton, seconded by David Thomas to approve the purchase of 2021 Boom Mower from Stephenson Equipment in the amount of \$68,900.00. Pending Inspection. Motion carried.

Sewer Authority Report:

1. Minor maintenance issues were addressed.

Water Authority Report:

1. Working on Lead abatement and starting repairs on Pump House #1. The authority also met with solicitors to come to an agreement on a Will Serve for the Kim Estates.
