MTC child supervision policy and Changing room Policy

MTC child supervision policy

MTC expects children under the age of 13 are supervised by their parents/carers whilst at the tennis club for play or any other reason.

Children under the agreed age of supervision should not be left unsupervised by a parent or carer even if there are other adult members of staff or parents present except when attending an organised event such as coaching sessions or a tennis camp. If the parent is unable to supervise their child, arrangements need to be made by the parent/carer to delegate to an alternative adult to provide supervision. The club and child must be aware of such arrangements.

Children under the agreed age of supervision should not be allowed to arrive or leave Marshfield Tennis Club alone unless the club have explicit consent from the parent/carer.

It is a parent/carers responsibility to teach their child how to respond to emergencies or situations that may arise outside the house, so they feel confident when their child is not under their supervision. Parents and carers are advised to refresh their knowledge of the following Marshfield Tennis Club policies.
