

MTC grounds, courts and clubhouse inspection, cleaning and maintenance policy

The MTC grounds, footpaths, courts and clubhouse will be inspected weekly. The inspection will include the emergency access and assembly point.

A record of the inspections and remedial action required will be maintained and displayed on the notice board in the mens changing area. Remedial action will be integrated into the maintenance/cleaning programme.

The maintenance/cleaning programme will include

Clubhouse

Cleaning weekly

Annual structural maintenance unless remedial action is required earlier

Pat testing annually

Fixed wiring inspection every 5 years

Grounds, footpaths and courts

Removal of leaves and debris as required

Remedial actions as required by inspections of nets and fixtures

Court deep cleaning and maintenance as per installers recommendations

Maintenance of electrical installations as per installers recommendations

Emptying of Septic tank every 5 years

Assorted Health and Safety issues

In the event of the courts becoming damaged and dangerous they will be cordoned off.

Members will be advised not to play on the courts in bad weather, icy conditions, thunderstorms and extreme heat.

Members will be instructed in the safe use of the ball machine before use.

Members should wear appropriate hard court tennis shoes when on court.

Members should be made aware that in icy and snowy conditions the communal footpath and car park will not be cleared of ice or snow.

Volunteers using the leaf blower will have access to safety spectacles and ear defenders.
