



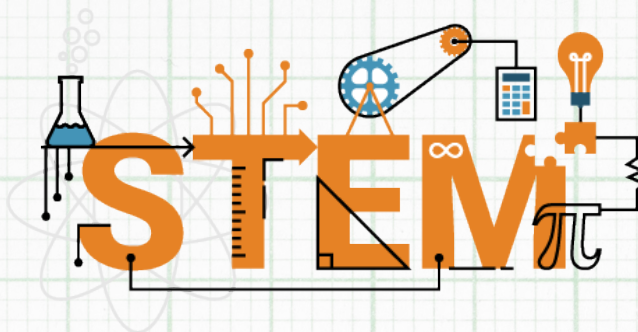
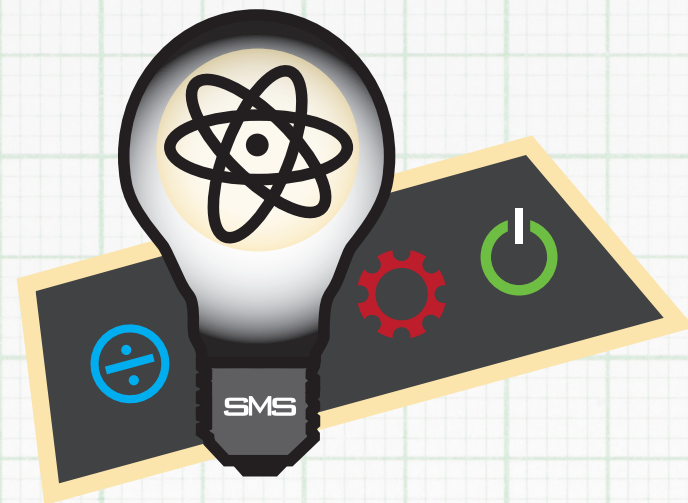
OUR HISTORY

2007—Vulcan Materials Company provided an Adopt-A-School partnership gift of \$15,000 to establish the first STEM Summer Camp at Sterling Elementary School. **Forty-two** (42) third, fourth, and fifth grade students attended a three week full day summer camp directed by Ruth Hood. Students were selected based upon the greatest need and their interest in science and math.

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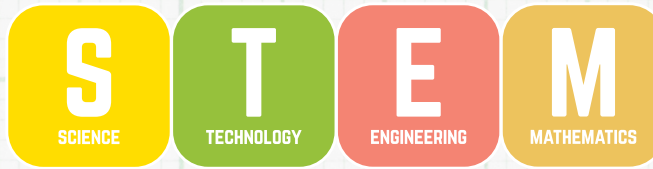
