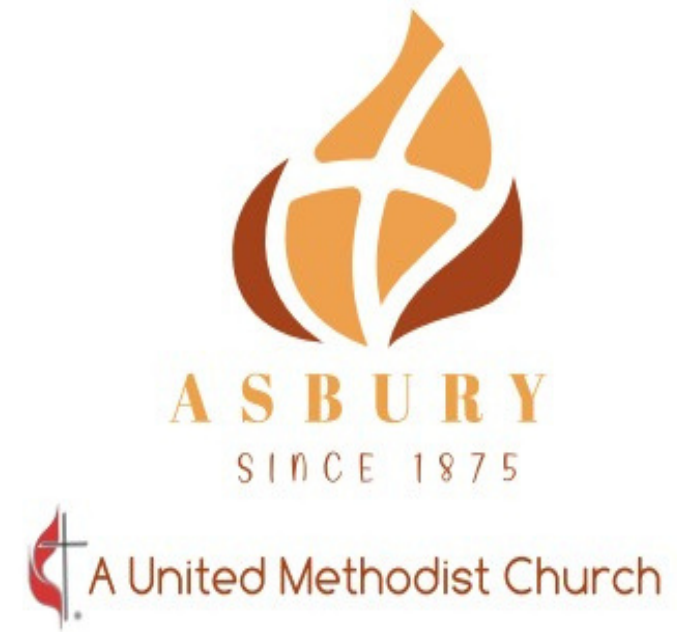
Community Outreach
