1 Corinthians 12:6–7 (NRSV): and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. 7 To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

Everyone has gifts of the Spirit! What a wonderful thought. God puts us together with others not because our gifts are the same but because they complement one another. This is the third time in 1 Corinthians that Paul identifies God as the actor for the distribution of the gifts. In other words, we don't choose our gifts, God gives them to us, with a purpose. Consider that when you have been given a gift from God, there is already a purpose for it. We do not have to know the purpose, in fact, it may not be possible for us to know the purpose, outside of the community.

I think it is important to understand that there are the fruits of the spirit that we all as children of God display. These fruits identify us as believers, followers of Christ. Paul recognizes these fruits in Galatians 5. The fruits are different from the gifts. We can display similar fruits but have completely different gifts.

I find myself amazed at people in the church who deny God's gifting in their lives simply because they don't want the gift or don't think they have the gift. In fact, many have not taken the time to learn what God has gifted them to do. Remember, our gifts from God do not act by themselves, they are a part of something greater. In order for their fulfillment to be made complete, we must use them as part of the body of Christ.

Do you know your gifts? I invite you to join us during the month of August as we look at identifying the gifts that God has given to us. After we identify the gifts we will then look at their use for God's common good.


























Greetings,
