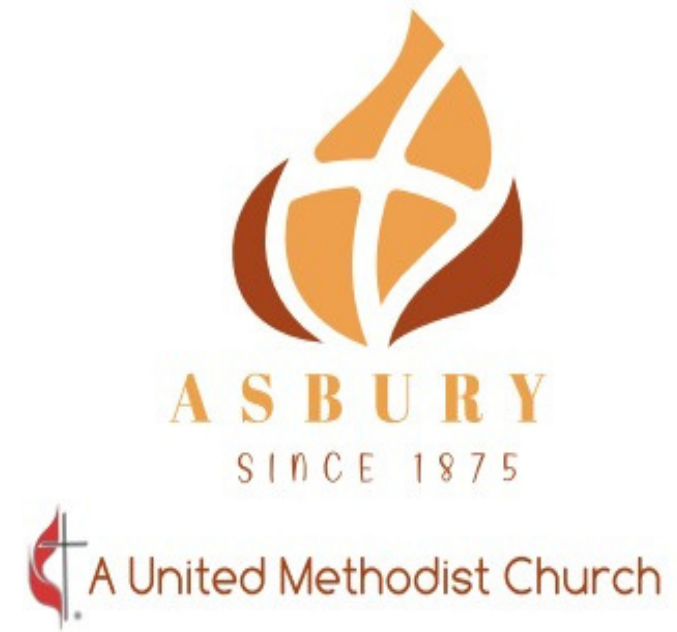
Community Outreach
