Michael Feely serves as the director of missions and congregational care at Christ UMC in Chattanooga TN. He formerly served as the executive director of a housing repair ministry called Mountain TOP in Tennessee, and before that was development director at Camp Lookout (GA) and Missions Advancement director at Henderson Settlement (KY) as well as pastoring several churches in the Holston Conference. He has served as an interim city council member in Chattanooga, as well as an adjunct history professor. He has served on numerous boards, including the Holston Foundation, the Community Foundation of Greater Chattanooga and Habitat for Humanity. He also attempts at times to play the trombone, and is a longtime member of the Chattanooga Gospel Orchestra.
