Gratitude is central to faith! Diana Butler Bass lifts up the idea that the root word in Greek and Latin for Gratitude is the same as Grace and Gift. Think of the exact same word being used to describe the gift, the reason for the gift and the response to the gift. For those of us in the Wesleyan tradition I think this is why we talk about three forms of grace; prevenient, justifying and sanctifying. However, I have always found it interesting that we don't really begin to understand until we find ourselves in sanctifying grace. This is when our gratitude for what God has done through the gift of grace comes to understanding the outflow of God's love.

Grace comes from God's deepest abundance. Our only faithful response can be one of gratitude. Until we are grateful for this gift and not ashamed we have not come to true faith in God. I think this is one of the biggest challenges for believers today. We have bought into this idea of debt and shame tied up in our own unworthiness. A lot of people believe they will never be worthy because of the shame they have over what they have done in their lives. This debt then becomes insurmountable.

Have you ever noticed how many parables about feast and coming to the table Jesus shares? Have you ever noticed how many times Jesus goes to join people at the table? Jesus came to do away with debt and shame by taking care of it once and for all: One Lord, One Faith, One baptism! Jesus came to share the abundance of God's table with us. In the parable of the prodigal "father", the culmination is the feast where the fatted calf is killed and all are invited to celebrate. We can respond with gratitude at the grace being poured or shame and debt!

I invite you into the season of Lent to explore the gift of grace given for you and to respond with gratitude.


