Deuteronomy 6:4-6 Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts.

On Wednesday March 2, 2022 we will begin the season of Lent. Lent is the period of 40 days before Easter, in which Sundays are not counted. The 40 days are the same number that Jesus spent in the wilderness (Matthew 4:1-11). The early church used these 40 days to prepare new believers for joining the church, and for those who had fallen away it was an opportunity to reconnect with the body of Christ. Lent is a season for individuals to draw closer to Jesus and concludes with what we refer to as Holy Week, from Palm Sunday to Easter.

The season of Lent is therefore set aside for personal reflection. For believers to examine their lives and through the means of grace: which include devotional reading of Scripture, prayer, fasting, the Lord's Supper, Christian conversation, and acts of service and compassion to our neighbors. It is in these means of grace that we encounter the presence of God in all its transforming and loving power. As we faithfully participate in means of grace through worship, sacrament, daily devotions, fellowship and service, God enables us to increasingly recover the divine image of love in which we were created. I want to encourage you to prepare yourselves during this Holy season of Lent.

At Asbury we consider how we can renew or strengthen our covenant with God. We will do this in worship by examining the aspects of spiritual disciplines and their role in growing our inner spiritual relationship, our outward physical relationship, and our corporate relationship with God. This will include an opportunity to reaffirm your faith relationship with God or perhaps for the first time share with others your faith. On the first Sunday in April, we will have the chance to make a commitment for 2022 to draw our lives ever closer to God. This will then lead us into Holy week which we hope will provide you the opportunity to hear those words from Jesus, John 11:25 Jesus said to , "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live"

I encourage you to join us in this Holy season of Lent, and consider what God through Jesus and the Holy Spirit is trying to share with you.




