Vacation Bible School

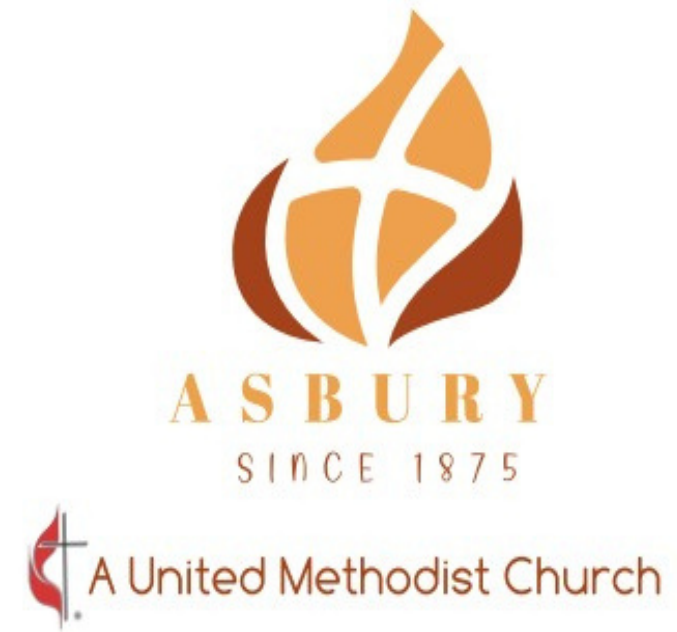
