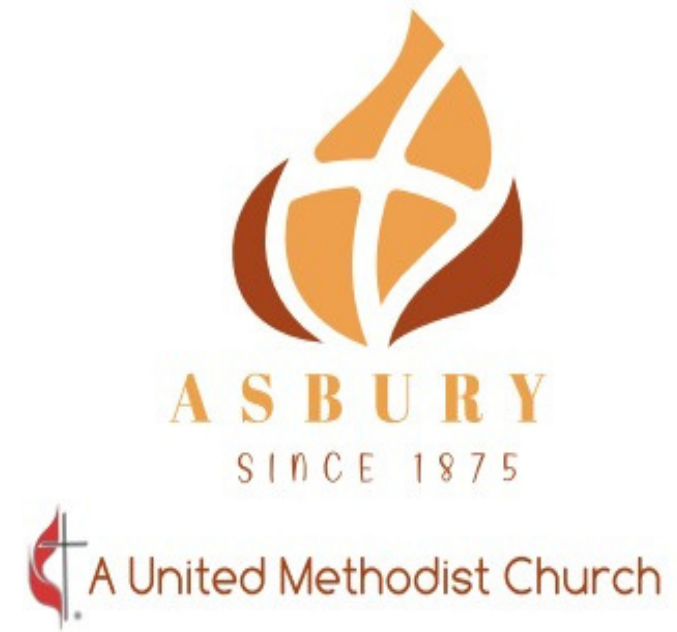
Community Outreach
