Prayer of Confession

Based on Joshua 4:1-7

Liturgist: God of ages past, our perplexing present, and our faith-filled future, we come before You, confessing that we have often diminished your role in our lives and failed to follow you in thought, word and deed. We failed to remember your mighty works in our lives. Like the Israelites who crossed the River Jordan our lives are in your hands. Liturgist: Renew our hearts, elevate our minds, and strengthen our resolve. Teach us to walk by faith and not by sight. Let us tell the story over and over about how you brought us out of bondage to freedom for generations to come. Let our story be a memorial!

All: In the name of Jesus Christ, our Rock and Redeemer, we pray. Amen.
