How safe is it to live in a London Borough if you are female?

The short answer, it is not safe. These statistics have been received from the Metropolitan Police under a Freedom of Information request.

From the year after the Labour Party came into power in 1998, through the coalition government to the Conservative Party holding the reins in 2019 these are some of the main statistics:

During this time, the number of officially recorded sexual assaults including rapes was staggeringly just under **110,000**. Up to 67% of these women were White and up to 23% were Afro-Caribbean.

Now, we would like to give you some reassurance and say the perpetrators had proceedings brought against them but despairingly we cannot. The statistics are getting worse in this area, in 1998 22% of these crimes saw some attempt to resolve them through prosecution, in 2019 this has gone down to only **8%**!

Who should you look out for, who are the most dangerous groups attacking women?

At least 45% but up to 77%* of perpetrators are from the BAME community

At least 23% but up to 45%* of perpetrators are from the White community

Are any Boroughs becoming more dangerous than others looking at recent trends?

The short answer is no, between 1998 and 2019 the number of victims in percentage terms compared with the total number of victims has changed very little.

Statistics

According to the Police statistics, over 14,500 perpetrators entries were "blank" i.e. the Police presumably simply did not complete the details. Interestingly, this lack of recording of these statistics has risen by 1761% since 1998, your guess is as good as ours as to why this is.

A further 1,700 perpetrators had an "Unknown" ethnicity – surely a reasoned guess would have helped.

The Police have commented "suspect's ethnicity is based on the perception of the victim and/or witnesses and therefore may not be as accurate as self defined ethnicity." Fair enough, but that doesn't answer why these "blank" statistics have risen by so much.

Are there any groups of people becoming more dangerous than others looking at trends over this time?

Yes, Oriental, Arabian & Egyptian average at least a 229% increase regarding the number of their victims between 1998 and 2019.

Afro-Caribbean and Asians average at least a 127% increase regarding the number of their victims between 1998 and 2019.

As a comparison the number of victims being attacked by the White population has increased by at least 35%.

NB A word of caution – the statistics will be higher as there are 31% of 2019 perpetrators where the Police have not recorded an ethnicity.

Our Plans

Have no doubt we guarantee to substantially reduce the numbers of rapes and sexual assaults on women in the UK. Including, as soon as we are in charge of the Country or we have the resources available to do so, we will create an App that you can press when you are out on your own to monitor your location until you arrive safely at your destination when you can switch the App off again. A little peace of mind in an increasingly soft and socialist society.

Conclusion

We get so angry with the blatantly incompetent Politicians playing lip service at election after election when questioned about crime and punishment but is clear for all of us to see, the statistics do not lie. To the 90,000 victims yet to receive justice, were are so sorry our great country has let you down – it may be too late for us to help you when we win a general election, but, please vote for us to save the next victim. Although the Police make mistakes, do not target your anger at them, they are limited by the law and resources. As we say the main culprits are the staggeringly incompetent Politicians, who have been running this Country for far too long.
