Not washing hands



Sex with infected partners



Eating/drinking contaminated food



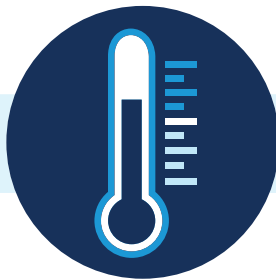
Recreational drug use

It can also be spread through close contact with someone infected with hepatitis A.

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?



Yellowing of skin + eyes



Fever



Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

Symptoms may also include: dark pee, pale poop, stomach pain, tiredness, lack of appetite.
If you have symptoms, please call your healthcare provider or local health department.

HOW DO I HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF HEPATITIS A?



Wash your hands with soap and water after using the bathroom and before eating/preparing food.



Get vaccinated if you are at high risk for getting hepatitis A.

WHO IS AT HIGH RISK?

- People who use recreational drugs
- Men who have sex with men
- People who are currently homeless or transient
- International travelers
