



I remember in a mighty struggle to see the blackboard in grade 9 and the headaches, pain from straining to attempt to make out the faint lines that seemed to mesh together at a distance. I could have moved from the back of the classroom to the front and made it easier, but I had my favourite desk...my spot that I didn't want to surrender.


Yes that plastic and metal chair was not the most comfortable but at the back of the room I didn't have to sit near the "brainier" people and I could hide and doodle! From where I was seated things were a blur and my notes seemed to match that.

When I first joined the sports teams I was stressed....how am I supposed to see...WITHOUT my glasses? As with the blackboard the field and all the other opposing jerseys were just a moving blur until I was suddenly in the midst of the action. It certainly made for some interesting outings and games having to focus so intently on the one point I thought the main activity was coming from, ignoring the remainder of the field. I will admit there were more than a few times I was blindsided and ended up in the turf with my limited perspective of the field.

Vision is critical, seeing how things are and make up all different aspects of things.

I had a prized microscope when I was young and would put everything under it to see the tiny details and amazed at what I could see in the microscopic world. I also had a fondness for telescopes to see the further reaches of what

my world could imagine seeing, the expanse of the cosmos! It's one thing to sit outside at night and look up at the twinkle twinkle little stars; but to be transported through a lens and see things from a different perspective was mind-blowing. It always amazed me what one could see when we just change our vantage point.




This constant seeking of clear vision taught me to *view things* from different points of view. In my backyard, the lights of the school distorted my vision. I had to move where there were no lights then I could see clearer and much more in depth the amazing map of the stars. See, I had to move and get into the right place in order to fully see; if I remained with the light in my eyes I would have not been able to enjoy the view of the stars opening up before me and been more than likely irritated at the lacklustre outcome.

So too it is in our walk with the Lord and life as a Christian...what is the focus of our vision..both our heart and mind? Peter gives us a great example of this, we read:

"But the boat was already a long distance from the land, battered by the waves; for the wind was contrary. And in the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea. When the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out in fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid."

*Peter said to Him, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." And He said, "Come!" And Peter got out of the boat, and walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But seeing the wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and took hold of him, and * said to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?"*

The Lord standing miraculously before Peter in the midst and surrounded by the storm ...got caught up in it! He took His eyes or we can say changed his perspective AWAY from the Lord being at the centre of his attention and trouble ensued.

How many times do we do the same thing; allow the waves of life to affect and distract us? What about that favourite place we like to sit in, is it really a good place for us to see what the LORD wants us to see or are we just comfortable in that place /thinking/ heart posture not wanting to move?

See just like all I had to do was move closer to the blackboard and I would be able to view all that was instructed, all we have to do is move closer to our Lord Jesus and HE WILL let us see all that He has for us. We just need to move from our broken, blurry perspective and see through the eyes of the word of God and His truth.
