



help...

I'm STUCK

I love older cars, growing up we had a red and white mustang (year unknown) and a Chevy Chevelle. The mustang had a broken small window in the front and I don't think the heater worked because I remember being frigid cold in that car! There wasn't any thermometer, just dials of varying heat ... but nothing poured out other than the chatter of my teeth chattering together. The Chevelle, though,

packed us all in warm in the winter with the heat being pumped out. Yet in the summer, boy did I wish there was something like A/C that we have today! The sun would beam in through the large windows, the heat would be screaming at me and my dad would turn on the FAN, which just blasted warm air against me. Again, no gauges or thermometer to tell you ... IT'S TOO HOT ... for little ole' me that is!!



Come to think about it, in all older cars there really wasn't ANY warning gauges until it was too late! No digital temperature display for that exact comfort, no cameras to help with

reversing and seeing all around your car and changing lanes. Certainly there were no sensors and directional warning sounds like today's high tech vehicles. No, driving before all our gadgets today required an understanding of the vehicle and what was happening to it on the road and with care.

Part of the care was the maintenance, knowing when the oil had to be changed, when a tune up was needed and when gas was low! See, the little red dash on the gas gauge was a general guide to warn you "get gas now or else you're stuck!!" The only way to really find out was to test it! Drive to the point of the red line and then continue driving and measure the distance before the clucking and choking engine sound started! Then for certain you would know how far you can go before you were truly stuck. If you were sharing a vehicle, it would be critical with low gas levels that you had enough to make it to

the local gas station with the remaining amount, of which you would have to know the distance and trust that the odometer was accurate, otherwise it would be a march to the pump with the jerrycan and a march back to top up some fuel and carry on. It probably happened more then we realize, people with an absent mind, forgetful, stuck in the middle of somewhere.

It sounds simple enough and we think, how can one forget to top up or fill the gas? Well, it requires us knowing the car and seeing the signs before we become stuck. See, the gauges gave us an idea but we had to pay attention, know how much the car was used, the distances driven the levels remaining of fuel. With life happening all around and the stresses of a hurried life, work, finances, family and ... you name it, people become forgetful and distracted.

Luckily cars today have evolved to give us so much information we can just look at the dashboard and see the estimated kilometers left. We actually get a steady warning with one hundred kilometers remaining so we can avoid the hazard of being stuck on the side of the road. Where one was not enough information, the other may be information overload. When one is overwhelmed or feeling stuck in life, it all stems from distractions.

As Christians we can become distracted from our faith. We read in the bible the product of sin and a life we that we were saved from - a life contrary to God.

"The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God."

Galatians 5:19-21

It's important we pay attention to our gauges and warning signs as to how we are doing - are we stressed, panicked, too busy? Does the priority of the Lord seem like work or another thing to add to your schedule? This is an unhealthy place spiritually and should also be a warning sign of a distracted life. We are called to love the Lord above all things:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."

Mark 12:30

Yet, the love due to the Lord is compromised when we become distracted and feel stuck in life. It robs us of the joy of experiencing the love and fulfillment of serving our Holy God. So, how are we to know and what do we do before we get stuck?

Trust in the Lord and take care of ourselves by paying attention to warning signs and understand

our limits. We don't want to be taking on too much in life (which can happen very quickly) and we also don't want to have so much idle time that we aren't growing. Idle time can be just as dangerous and leaves room for many other things to distract us ...

"and do not give the devil a foothold." Ephesians 4:27

Cars have varying gauges and warnings to signal a problem and get your attention, we have the Lord who directs us and speaks lovingly and guide our life. When we come before HIM, seeking His council and the will of the living God - our attention is fully on HIM. No distractions, fully attentive in the presence of God is how we become unstuck.

Hello everyone! Jacob and Laura here. Last week, we spoke about a teaching of our Lord Jesus that He us. commands all of us to follow - do to others as you would have them do to you. As I'm sure you have seen on social media, last week, a fellow believer named Charlie Kirk was murdered. Charlie, like many of our fellow believers in Christ across the world, was persecuted and killed for what he believed. Now to make it clear, we don't take a political stance on any issues, we simply live by what the word of God says.

With that being said, it is a terrible, sad thing when we see this type of extreme violence and hatred on display and we mourn over the loss of Charlie's life. We have seen some responses on social media - celebrating the death of a man simply because they hated his viewpoints and opinions. As the Bible teaches us, these responses come from the same place of murder, as anyone who hates a brother or sister is a murderer in heart (1 John 4:20). We know that these types of events can be a lot to process. Whether you know a lot about Charlie or not, we can start to feel a sense of revenge and hatred in our own hearts or confusion at this injustice, whatever

But Laura and I want encourage you all - what should we do with the hurt we may feel, the potential revenge or anger that rises up in our hearts when someone has acted in this evil way? Our Lord Jesus says in Matthew 5:44 "love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." Rather than let ourselves be consumed by the same hatred, anger and violence that we have seen on display, we must pray for all those involved. We pray for everyone who persecutes those who believe in Our Lord Jesus and all believers who are suffering persecution, all across the world. It is through our collective prayerful response as the body of Christ that the love of God reigns. We know and trust that God will have the final say as we stand firm in His love and we pray that all would come to see the truth and repent of their wicked ways. God bless you all.





Please Pray to John and Rebecca that the Lord continue to use His servants for His will, that in this season there be a miraculous move of the Lord and healing in their lives.


