Marching To The Cross

It's Easter season.

I remember when I was in grade school and the teacher would announce an Easter egg hunt during the day, boy that was exciting! Going to school and getting *CHOCOLATE!!* All I could eat (I didn't realize I had to work and find them first!)

Sometimes, usually after lunch there would be story time. I lost count how many times I heard Benjamin bunny, my mind was preoccupied with the previous announcement and all I could think about to be honest was...where's the chocolate?!



It would be about 1:30 or 2:00 in the afternoon when the story (finally!) wrapped up. Instead if heading back to our desks, ANOTHER announcement! I was giddy, salivating, really? Was it time? YES!! No work, and a feast of chocolate! I would dart, march around looking anywhere and everywhere, it was a matter of claiming the most you see.

OH those eggs, filled with creamy gooey centres, and the solid chocolate eggs.

Cadbury you out did yourselves! Needless to say, I too outdid myself and didn't want to see a drop of chocolate for ...days!

As I look back, it's interesting to see that Easter was promoted and filled with all types of activities and festivals, but I don't recall any mention of our Lord Jesus Christ in school. Sure, the bunnies, the tulips, the

spring time and all that, but the TRUE reason for Easter ...absent.

It makes me wonder, sad really, about how at a young age (and older) people are filling their lives with activities and things that have very little meaning, and just satiating pleasures of the moment. Like all the chocolate I had gathered (not needed) and over-consumed for a forty seven pound child, the sugar to weight ratio was astounding... no wonder the queasy, sick sensation. That would be like an adult consuming 5 to 6 dozen Krispy Kreme donuts in 24 hours, not good!

So, what about other things people fill their lives with? All purposeful in captivating and appealing to our carnal, physical senses, our wants and desires. Distractions, all of them. You see there's a host of carnal things (food, money, drugs, alcohol, smoking, sex, gambling, shopping, food to name a few) when they are given primary importance in our lives, they capture us and the more we allow the prominence of these behaviours, the more difficult to break the dependency. For some, they take hold driving a need, a craving and desire for these things to feel better. The satisfaction they bring, these are addictions.

When these fill our lives, what is the outcome? Like the effects of excessive chocolate consumption, not good, and it's enough to ...make you physically, emotionally and spiritually sick. These are the things the world is promoting in their

marketing campaign to win the hearts, minds and dare I say ...the souls of the people.

It's an interesting approach, the rule of marketing is feed (insert item name here) it to them until the object becomes top in their minds, thoughts and a household name. Feed it to them until they can't take anymore, then feed them more! This approach leaves no space for ANYTHING else and so we see constant competition for the space in our minds, hearts which leave no room for anything else.

Interestingly, we read this in the Bible:

"neither give place to the devil."

Ephesians 4:27

Another translation uses the words "space" or "opportunity". This is why we are to also do as it is written:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."

Matthew 22:37

So we have some competing things here!
On one hand we have the marketing
machine of the world pushing "things",
stirring up our feelings and desires; to act
on/out these actions and to satisfy them with
the object that has seduced us. The
marketing has overtaken us!

On the other side, we have the Word of Truth, the Word of God *telling us NOT to*

love the world and the things there in, not to love ANYTHING more that God Himself!

We are called to love the LORD with ALL of our heart, soul and mind. How can we do that when the worlds marketing is allowed to take "top" spot? Here then is the choice, do we live to satisfy our carnal desires or in the spirit to please God? In a previous newsletter we spoke about the need to live and honour the Lord in Spirit, to be spiritual not carnal (though for now we live here).

Living in love of the world demotes the Lord from being FIRST in our hearts, soul and minds...we don't give God the "ALL" that He asks us to. In so doing we leave room, opportunity that allows the marketing to overtakes us.

Neither of these are neutral. The Bible draws us closer into a more intimate relationship with our Saviour, our Father and the Holy Spirit. This is the spiritual life, the craving of the word, the change it brings, the peace and joy that washes over us. The Word purposefully draws us *closer to God*.

Marketing on the other hand replaces the space in our heart, soul and mind reserved for GOD with *other things*, tantalizing and drawing us away from the "ALL" we are asked to give Him. This is how the top position in our lives overtake our love of God and relationship with Him.

We read what James wrote:

"You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity

against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God."

James 4:4

Love of the world that overtakes the love of God will make us ill! It's a disease far worse than too much chocolate and Krispy Kreme donuts. When our lives are lived in a carnal way, loving the world and spurring God, the affliction of sin is waiting and it is severe. But, we thank the Lord for He and He alone has the cure, the sacrifice on the cross to pay for our sins. This is Easter, this is The treat, this is the Love we should all know and share.
