

1 Corinthians 13:11

Now Paul was speaking about spiritual growth in this analogy of a childlike development, but it really is no different. As a child we grew on milk that nourished us, and eventually we grew and were able to handle the heartiness of solid food, to increase our strength and stamina. As a Christian we learn the foundation and fundamental things of the faith which is our early stage of spritual growth. Yet we do not stop there! Paul in Hebrews 5:13-14 goes on with the instruction of growth

of the Christian spiritual life:

"For everyone who partakes <u>only of milk</u> is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for he <u>is an infant</u>. But <u>solid food</u> is f<u>or the mature</u>, who <u>because of practice</u> have their senses trained to discern good and evil."

Peter instructs us to desire the growth and maturity from the Word of God, retraining us: "Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation, if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord."

1 Peter 2:1-3

Yes, laying aside the carnal behaviours we have learned in this life and let The Word of God change and cleanse us, maturing us spiritually.




