
Dress Code Policies

The dress code is intended to create a standard of dress that is neat, modest and promotes a visible sense of school unity and professional style. We anticipate the cooperation of parents in ensuring their students' adherence to the dress code. In all cases, the administration has final determination of standards of dress and appearance.

Enforcement of Dress Code

Failure to follow the dress code policies will result in the students receiving an infraction.

***Solid khaki pants/shorts are permitted and be uniform style to include a waistband and belt loops. Must not touch the ground or be shorter than the top of the ankle bone. Straight leg, hemmed and well fitted at the waistband (Example: Dockers™, classic style or traditional uniform style). Fabric should be cotton, cotton blend or polyester blend. No side stripe, bell bottom, cargo, carpenter, hip hugger, slim fit, skinny or jogger style. Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than 3" from the middle of the knee.**

School Day Uniform Girls

Girls 1st - 5th (Maroon/Plaid #54/Khaki)

- Tops: Maroon Polo w/ Sacred Heart Logo
- Bottoms: Skort, Skirt, *Khaki Shorts or Pants *Must be worn with belt (solid brown or black)
- Jumper: White Peter Pan Blouse w/no logo. Worn with #194 Tunic Jumper

Mass/Formal Attire for 1st - 5th will be their everyday uniform **No Shorts on Mass Days

Girls 6th-8th (Gray/Plaid #54/Khaki)

- Tops: Gray Polo w/ Sacred Heart Logo
- Bottoms: Skirt, *Khaki Shorts or Pants *Must be worn with a belt (solid brown or black)

Mass/Formal Attire

- Option 1: White Oxford w/Cross Tie, Khaki Pants, Plaid Skirt, Maroon Blazer w/ Sacred Heart Logo, Black or Navy over the ankle socks, Solid Black or Brown Dress Shoes
- Option 2: ¾ Sleeve Blouse w/Logo, Plaid Skirt, Maroon Blazer/Logo, Navy or White Knee Socks, Solid Black or Brown Dress Shoes

Girls 9th-12th (Navy/Plaid #54/Khaki)

- Tops: Navy Polo w/ Sacred Heart Logo
- Bottoms: Skirt, *Khaki Shorts or Pants *Must be worn with a belt (solid brown or black)

Mass/Formal Attire

- Option 1: White Oxford w/Cross Tie, Khaki Pants, Plaid Skirt, Maroon Blazer w/ Sacred Heart Logo, Black or Navy over the ankle socks, Solid Black or Brown Dress Shoes

- Option 2: $\frac{3}{4}$ Sleeve Blouse w/Logo, Plaid Skirt, Maroon Blazer/Logo, Navy or White Knee Socks, Solid Black or Brown Dress Shoes

School Day Uniform Boys

Boys 1st - 5th (Maroon/Khaki)

- Tops: Maroon Polo w/ Sacred Heart Logo
- Bottoms: *Khaki Shorts or Pants *Must be worn with belt(solid brown or black)

Mass/Formal Attire for 1st - 5th will be their everyday uniform **No Shorts on Mass Days

Boys 6th-8th (Gray/Plaid #54/Khaki)

- Tops: Gray Polo w/ Sacred Heart Logo
- Bottoms: *Khaki Shorts or Pants *Must be worn with a belt(solid brown or black)

Mass/Formal Attire

- Option 1: White Oxford w/Plaid Tie, Khaki Pants, Maroon Blazer w/ Sacred Heart Logo, Black or Navy over the ankle socks, Solid Black or Brown Dress Shoes

Boys 9th-12th (Navy/Plaid #54/Khaki)

- Tops: Navy Polo w/ Sacred Heart Logo
- Bottoms: *Khaki Shorts or Pants *Must be worn with a belt(solid brown or black)

Mass/Formal Attire

- Option 1: White Oxford w/Plaid Neck or Bow Tie, Khaki Pants, Maroon Blazer w/ Sacred Heart Logo, Black or Navy over the ankle socks, Solid Black or Brown Dress Shoes

****NO SHORTS OR ATHLETIC SHOES ARE ALLOWED ON MASS DAYS**

Footwear

Boys must wear only dress shoes or athletic footwear. Girls must wear closed-toed shoes that cover the heel or athletic footwear. No student may wear sandals, slippers, or Crocs of any type. High end designer shoes are not permitted.

Outerwear

Must be Sacred Heart sold by Zogbhy's or school sponsored. Sweatshirts and sweaters must be the appropriate color for the class the student is in. (A dress code shirt must be worn under any type of outerwear.) Sacred Heart Jackets (Anorak or Rugger) are to be left in lockers during class time.

Grooming

Anything that draws undue attention to the student and/or serves as a distraction is prohibited. Hair styles must reflect a neat and clean appearance. Haircuts must be moderate. Males must be clean shaven.

Miscellaneous

Jewelry is permitted but not to be excessive and is limited to bracelets, necklaces and earrings. Female students may wear no more than two earrings in each ear. Male students are not permitted to wear earrings. Other visible body piercings are not permitted.

Non-Uniform Day

There will be designated days throughout the year where students will be able to dress out of uniform.

The following guidelines must be followed:

- Jeans may be worn. Jeans have to be in good condition meaning no tears, cuts, or slits.
- Leggings are allowed only if accompanied by an oversized shirt or tunic style top.
- Any kind of Sacred Heart shirt is permitted.

Physical Education/Athletic Training Uniforms

Students in grades 6th-9th have the opportunity to dress out. Please contact the front office for order info.

Medical Excuse for Out-of-Uniform

A student must have a note from a physician for any medical reason to be out-of-uniform, shoes included. The note must contain the length of time the student will be out-of-uniform. The student must wear the appropriate articles of the school uniform whenever possible. Parental requests for being out-of-uniform for medical reasons and to the dress code are handled by the Administration.
