2025 Pool Information

Pool Hours: 1 PM - 7 PM Thursday thru Monday 5/24/25 - 8/04/25

1 PM - 7 PM Saturday and Sunday 8/09/25 - 9/28/25 Hours and days may vary depending on the weather and staffing.

Pool Badges: Pool badges will only be issued to **EITHER** the homeowner or the tenant, not both. **Only Members in good standing** will be allowed the use of the facility with a current badge. For Homeowner badges the Homeowner must sign for each family member in the household using the badge. Proof of residence is required. Acceptable proof includes Driver's License or State ID. If address on the picture id is not a Huntwyck address a current bill with name matching the id will be required. For tenant badges: The Landlord/Homeowner must sign a tenant authorization form granting permission for Tenant and family members who live with the tenant year-round to obtain pool badges. This form **must be notarized** and updated each pool season. The Landlord/Homeowner must also be in good standing to grant this permission.

Pool badges are required for admittance to the pool. Pool rules are posted at the facility and copies can be obtained online at huntwyckvillage.com, from the office, or the pool supervisor. All pool rules must be followed, or the Pool Supervisor/Asst. Supervisor has the right to reject any person. Incident reports will be written, and repeated violators will be referred to the board for appropriate action. There will be a \$5.00 Replacement Fee for lost badges.

Guests: Homeowner must remain in attendance while guests are using the facility. Guest Passes may be purchased by a homeowner. Tenants may not buy guest passes.

\$30 for a 6 Person Pass \$50 for a 10 Person Pass \$100 for a 20 Person Pass

Each lot is allowed up to a total of **six** guests per visit at one time with a visitors pass. The number of guests allowed at a time is subject to change for those who do not follow rules and regulations. Tenants can not buy guest passes.

Extended Season Visitor Badges are available for \$125.00 and are good for one person for one season. The application for an extended season badge must come from a homeowner in good standing who holds a pool badge.

There will be no Lifeguards on duty.

Homeowners/Tenants and their guests understand that use of the Pool Facility is at their own risk.
