Battle of the Bridge Canned Food Drive: August means the start of school and that means our annual Battle of the Bridge Football Game (Friday, August 26th at LC) with Trinity again participating in the annual Battle of the Bridge Canned Food Drive and competition. Beginning today and for the next two Sundays, Trinity will join with others in the community by donating canned goods to benefit families in Loudon County. Good Samaritan will collect the food and ultimately distribute it too. This drive collects the largest amount of food each year for those families and children in our community who are food insecure.

While shopping, please consider picking up an extra canned good or two for a needy family. You may place your items in the designated basket in the Education hallway.

If it is more convenient, you may make a donation by writing "Battle of the Bridge" on the memo line of your check or offering envelope. One dollar equals 5lbs of food. However you wish to participate, we say "Thank You!!!"
