Marilyn Peterson was raised in Burbank, California, and began her music studies at the age of 4. Her mother, a professional pianist/organist, mentored her during daily practice sessions, helping her to progress quickly. She performed her first solo recital and also played as a soloist with concert band at the age of 11. After graduation from Burbank High School, she attended Los Angeles Pierce College where she was hired as the staff accompanist, a job she held for 9 years even after graduating with her AA in Music.

During her teen years she won numerous competitions and scholarships including the coveted Ferde Grofé (Grand Canyon Suite) Award, presented by the composer himself. She was a three-time winner of the Los Angeles Concerto/Aria Contest, on each occasion having the privilege of performing a concerto with full orchestra.

Marilyn has recorded three solo CD's: Beside Still Waters-a collection of her improvisational styles designed as quiet background music; My Favorite Classics which include selections by Chopin, Liszt and Debussy; and Christmas At Our House-a celebration of sacred and pop holiday favorites. She also joined soprano Gail Beckman on a CD called A Mixed Bouquet--Hand Picked Favorites which includes selections from their first of many concerts together.

In 2011 Marilyn was a contestant in the Ms. Senior Nevada Pageant. She was selected as the First Runner-Up along with taking home the top award in the talent category for the performance of her Phantom of the Opera Medley.

Marilyn lives in Tellico Village with her husband John after moving from Northern California in 2023. Currently she is the pianist at Trinity United Methodist Church in Lenoir City and performs at various senior living facilities and other venues in the Knoxville area.
