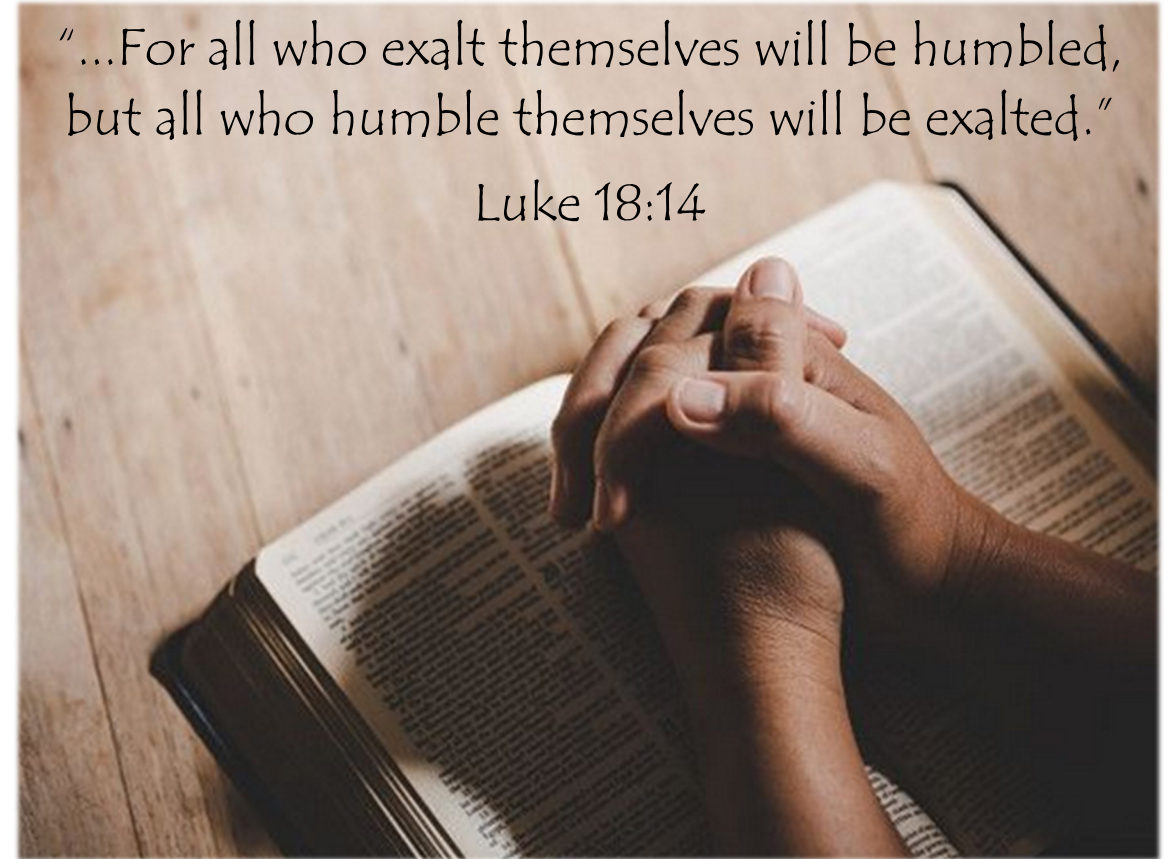
Online Giving at Trinity
