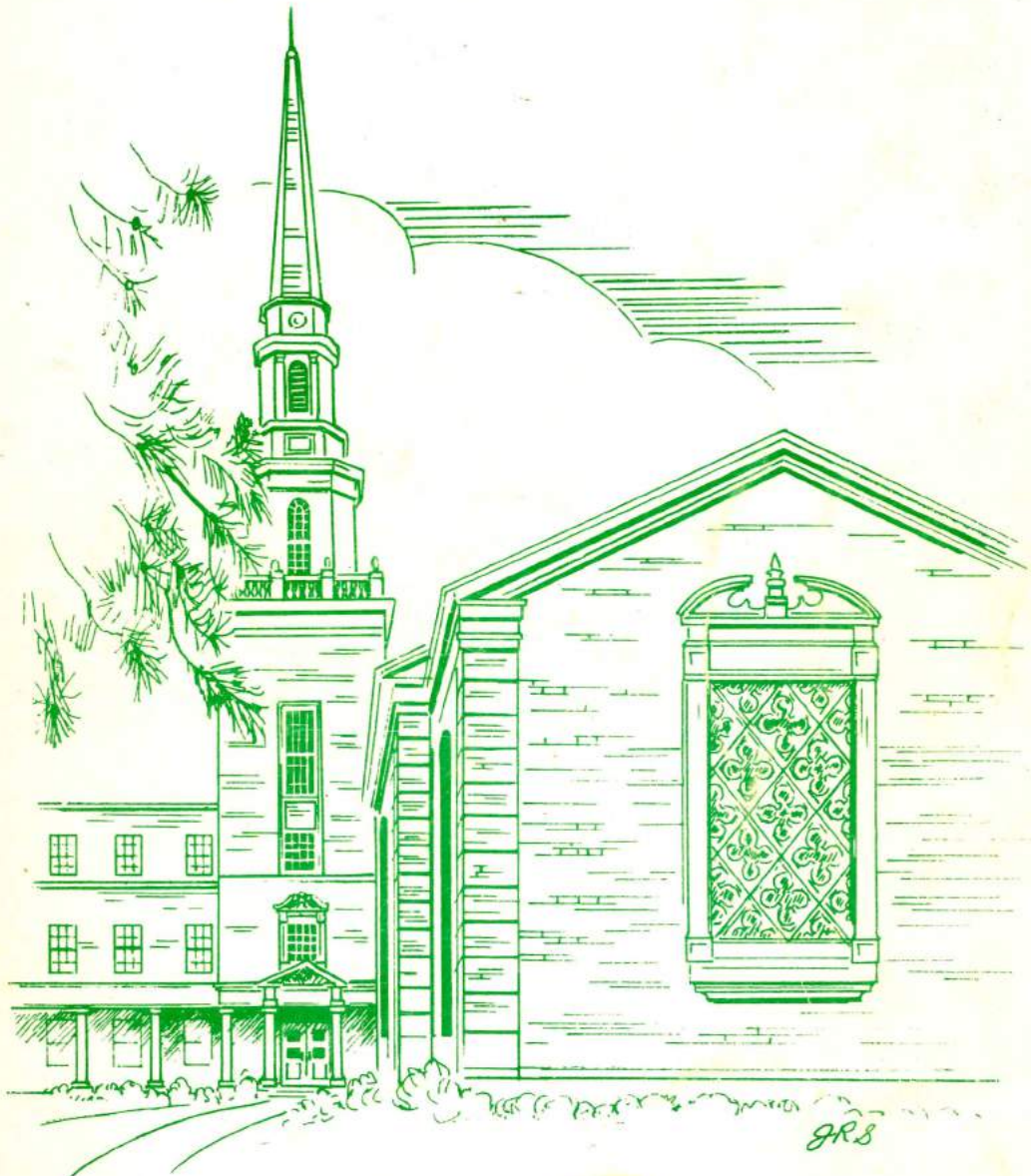

HISTORY OF ALTA WOODS BAPTIST CHURCH 1947-1970



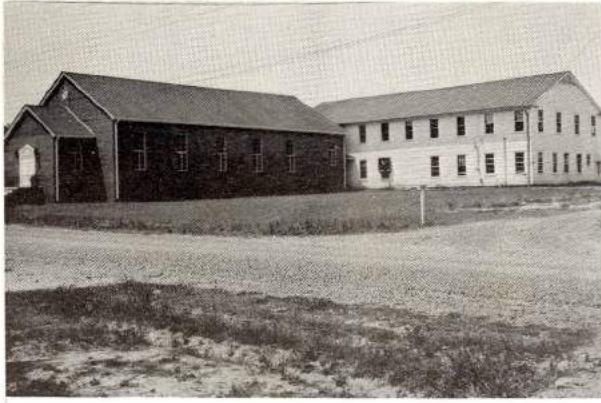
secretary, Mississippi Baptist Convention Board, was the evangelist for the meeting. On Sunday May 2, 1947, following the Revival the Alta Woods Baptist church was organized with 54 charter members and Rev. Barnhill was called as pastor. Property, where the present buildings are located were purchased for \$3,855.00. The following Saturday the men erected a small tabernacle which was used for the worship service on Sunday. The first budget was \$5,000 with \$420 being given to missions through the Cooperative program.



As soon as possible a two story frame structure was begun. This building was occupied in the winter of 1948 though it remained unfinished inside and the outside was covered with black felt paper.



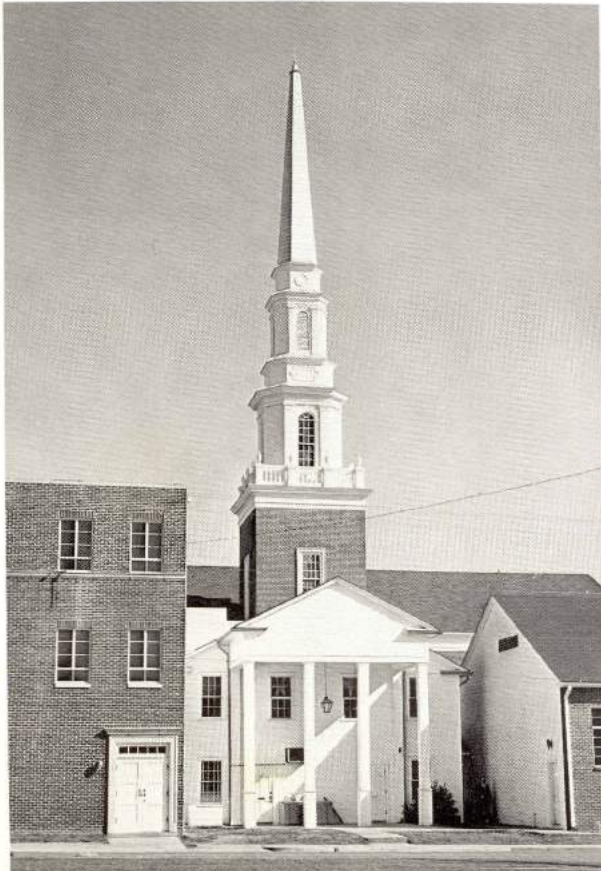
In September 1948, Rev. Barnhill resigned and in November Rev. Clyde Davis, a ministerial student in Mississippi College was called as pastor. He served the church for two years and saw the membership grow from 95 to 251, the Sunday school from 58 to 267 and the Training Union from 25 to 122. It was during this period that a Brotherhood was organized, a music director, a church secretary and seven deacons were elected by the church. The building was completed and a pastorium was purchased on Arbor Hill Drive. Bro. Davis resigned in October 1950.



Rev. Percy Cooper became Pastor of the church in December 1950. In March 1951 the pastorium was sold and the lot on which the tent revival had been held was purchased for \$1,500 and a new pastorium was built. In September of 1951 a brick chapel was finished at a cost of \$25,000, and in 1952 a lot across the street south from the chapel was purchased for a parking area. Two weeks later the lot behind the Pastorium on Oakhurst was also purchased for a parking area. In November 1953 the East wing of the three story educational building was

completed at a cost of \$65,000. Some additional lots joining the parking area across Oakhurst street were purchased in 1956. In June 1957 the West end of the three story educational building was completed at a cost of \$165,000. On July 30, 1958 Rev. Cooper resigned after seven and a half years of effective leadership.

Dr. Joe H. Cothen became pastor September 14, 1958. In August 1959 three acres of ground west of the parking area on Oakhurst was purchased for \$7,000. In May 1961 ground-breaking was held for the construction of new auditorium designed to seat 1356 people and to cost approximately \$410,000. The two houses across the street south from the church were purchased to be used for educational space and additional property to be used for parking. In 1961 a new pastorium was built at 442 Cummins and the former pastorium was converted into educational space. In 1964 a Children's building was built on the tract of ground west of the church at a cost of \$125,000. In 1966 a home was purchased at 2334 Coronet Place to be furnished for a foreign missionary family home on furlough. In March of 1966 the white frame building which the church had used from the beginning was torn down and replaced with a three story educational and office building at a cost of \$300,000. Dr. Cothen brought his ten year ministry with the church to a close the last Sunday in July in 1968.

OUR PASTOR



DR. CHARLES E. MYERS
PASTOR

Our pastor is a product of and possesses the spirit of the progressive Southwest. Born in Tulsa, Oklahoma, where he attended public schools, he received his college and seminary training in Texas.

While he was a student in Baylor University, he met Miss Beatrice Wilbanks, who was serving on the Baptist Student Union Council with him. After graduation from Baylor and at the end of his second year in Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, they were married. At the time of their marriage he was serving a part time church at Rankin, Texas, a small rural community.

In May, 1943 he received his Master's Degree in Theology; and in August the couple moved to Sulphur, Oklahoma, where they served the First Baptist Church for eight years. During this time he received his Doctorate in Theology from Southwestern Baptist Seminary. It was also during this pastorate that the couple's only child, Martha Jean, was born.

In March, 1951, the family moved to McKinney, Texas, where they served the First Baptist Church for eleven years. On January 19, 1962, they moved to McAlester, Oklahoma, where they served the First Baptist Church for seven years. In September 15, 1968 Dr. Myers assumed the pastorate of this church. The past two and a half years have been eventful years in which the people and the pastor have been mutually blessed by the Lord's Leadership.

Dr. Myers has been honored in many ways by the denomination in Texas, Oklahoma, and Mississippi. He has served on several boards and committees of Associational, State and Southern Baptist Convention. He has spoken for several years on Master Control, a ministry of the Radio and Television Commission. He recently has served as President of the Hinds Baptist Ministerial Association, is on our Associational Finance Committee, and is Vice Chairman of The Mississippi Christian Action Commission.

But he has said repeatedly that his greatest honor is to be a pastor of a Baptist Church.

1970-71 PROGRAM FEATURES

1. Fully Graded Sunday School (44 Departments, 117 Classes), Church Training Program, Brotherhood, and Woman's Missionary Union.
2. Music - 7 Choirs (ages 4-up), Ladies and Mens Chorus, Small Ensembles, ranked 5th in number enrolled in Mississippi in 1970.
3. Missions - 20% of 1971 budget designated to missions. In addition, a home at 2334 Coronet Place is furnished, rent free, and utilities paid for Foreign Missionary families home on furlough. Foreign Mission offering in December 1969 topped \$7,000.00. Youth have taken mission tours the past three years to Montana, Colorado and Minnesota.
4. Youth - directed by full time Minister of Youth Education - modern youth center - recreation - retreats - camps - counseling.
5. Senior Adults - meet every Tuesday, 2:00 p.m. for programs, service projects, tours and recreation.
6. Family Emphasis - Wednesday night program begins with family meal at 5:45 p.m., followed by Mission Education and Teaching Improvement at 6:30, Prayer Meeting at 7:30, and Adult Choir Rehearsal at 8:15.
7. Children - a Day Care and Kindergarten program rated as one of the best and largest in Mississippi with some 350 children enrolled, employing 32 people.
8. Stewardship - 1971 Budget totals \$324,000.00 with an additional \$110,000.00, annual income for the Kindergarten Day Care program.
9. "I Job" Policy - a person may serve in only one major position annually; 428 different persons hold these places of service.
10. Special Education - provisions made for those who need specialized care during Sunday school and morning worship.
11. Hinds County Penal Farm - every third Sunday 3:00 p.m., AWBC provides evangelistic services at our county penitentiary.
12. Inglewood Nursing Home - Sunday school, worship, and visitation conducted weekly by AWBC.
13. Deacons - 41 active deacons with 1/3 rotating annually.
14. Committees - 21 Standing Committees composed of 136 persons. 1/3 committee members rotating annually. A High School age young person serving on most committees.
15. Media Center - contains Slides, Filmstrips, movie and overhead projectors, recordings, and more than 3200 books in all categories for all ages.
16. Long Range Planning Committee - meeting regularly to evaluate and recommend to church programs and buildings needed in future to meet the needs of our community.
17. Recreation - basketball and softball teams for men, women and youth; banquets, family socials, annual Church Carnival.
18. Bus - great for trips, tours, retreats, day camps, etc.
