Love: strong affection for another arising out of kinship or personal ties; attraction based on sexual desire: affection and tenderness felt by lovers; affection based on admiration, benevolence, or common interests; an assurance of affection; warm attachment, enthusiasm, or devotion; a beloved person; unselfish loyal and benevolent concern for the good of another: such as (1): the fatherly concern of God for humankind (2): brotherly concern for others;

1. AMP: Love endures with patience and serenity,

MSG: Love never gives up.

Endure: to continue in the same state; to remain firm under suffering or misfortune without yielding; to undergo especially without giving in

Patience: the capacity, habit, or fact of being patient

<u>Patient</u>: bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint; manifesting forbearance under provocation or strain; not hasty or impetuous; steadfast despite opposition, difficulty, or adversity; able or willing to bear;

Serenity: a state of utter calm and unruffled repose or quietude

<u>Give Up</u>: to yield control or possession of: SURRENDER; to desist from: ABANDON; to declare incurable or insoluble; to abandon (oneself) to a particular feeling, influence, or activity; to despair of seeing

2. AMP: love is kind and thoughtful,

MSG: Love cares more for others than for self.

<u>Kind:</u> of a sympathetic or helpful nature; of a forbearing nature: GENTLE; arising from or characterized by sympathy or forbearance

<u>Gentle</u>: free from harshness, sternness, or violence; SOFT, DELICATE; HONORABLE, DISTINGUISHED;

<u>Thoughtful</u>: absorbed in thought: MEDITATIVE; characterized by careful reasoned thinking; having thoughts: HEEDFUL; given to or chosen or made with heedful anticipation of the needs and wants of others

<u>Cares</u>: regard coming from desire or esteem; responsibility for or attention to health, well-being, and safety; a person or thing that is an object of attention, anxiety, or solicitude; to be concerned about or to the extent of

3. AMP: and is not jealous or envious;

MSG: Love doesn't want what it doesn't have.

<u>Jealous:</u> hostile toward a rival or one believed to enjoy an advantage: ENVIOUS; intolerant of rivalry or unfaithfulness; disposed to suspect rivalry or unfaithfulness; vigilant in guarding a possession

Envious: feeling or showing envy

Envy: painful or resentful awareness of an advantage enjoyed by another joined with a desire to possess the same advantage; obsolete: MALICE; an object of envious notice or feeling

4. AMP: love does not brag

MSG: Love doesn't strut,

Brag: a pompous or boastful statement; arrogant talk or manner: COCKINESS; to talk boastfully; to assert boastfully

Strut: to become turgid: SWELL; to walk with a proud gait; to walk with a pompous and affected air; to parade something with a show of pride

5. AMP: and is not proud or arrogant.

MSG: Doesn't have a swelled head,

<u>Proud</u>: feeling or showing pride: such as a: having or displaying excessive self-esteem, b: much pleased: EXULTANT, c: having proper self-respect; marked by stateliness: MAGNIFICENT; giving reason for pride: GLORIOUS

<u>Arrogant</u>: exaggerating or disposed to exaggerate one's own worth or importance often by an overbearing manner; showing an offensive attitude of superiority: proceeding from or characterized by arrogance

Swelled Head: an exaggerated opinion of oneself: SELF-CONCEIT

6. AMP: It is not rude;

MSG: Doesn't force itself on others,

<u>Rude</u>: being in a rough or unfinished state: CRUDE; NATURAL, RAW; PRIMITIVE,

UNDEVELOPED; SIMPLE, ELEMENTAL; lacking refinement or delicacy; offensive in manner

or action: DISCOURTEOUS; UNCIVILIZED, SAVAGE; COARSE, VULGAR

Force: strength or energy exerted or brought to bear: cause of motion or change: active power; capacity to persuade or convince; violence, compulsion, or constraint exerted upon or against a person or thing; the quality of conveying impressions intensely in writing or speech

7. AMP: it is not self-seeking,

MSG: Isn't always "me first,"

Self-Seeking: the act or practice of selfishly advancing one's own ends; seeking only to further one's own interests

8. AMP: it is not provoked [nor overly sensitive and easily angered];

MSG: Doesn't fly off the handle,

<u>Provoked</u>: to call forth (a feeling, an action, etc.): EVOKE; to stir up purposely; to stir up purposely; to incite to anger; to arouse to a feeling or action

Overly: to an excessive degree: TOO

<u>Sensitive</u>: highly responsive or susceptible: such as a: easily hurt or damaged, especially: easily hurt emotionally; delicately aware of the attitudes and feelings of others, b: excessively or abnormally susceptible: HYPERSENSITIVE, c: readily affected or changed by various agents; calling for tact, care, or caution in treatment: TOUCHY

Easily: in an easy manner: without difficulty; without question: by far;

<u>Angered</u>: a strong feeling of displeasure and usually of antagonism; a threatening or violent appearance or state

<u>Fly off the Handle</u>: to lose control of one's emotions: to become very angry

9. AMP: it does not take into account a wrong endured.

MSG: Doesn't keep score of the sins of others,

<u>Take into account:</u> to give attention or consideration to (something)

Wrong: an injurious, unfair, or unjust act: action or conduct inflicting harm without due provocation or just cause; a violation or invasion of the legal rights of another; not right or proper according to a code, standard, or convention: IMPROPER; not in accordance with one's needs, intent, or expectations; without regard for what is proper or just;

Endure: to continue in the same state; to remain firm under suffering or misfortune without yielding; to undergo especially without giving in

<u>Keep Score</u>: to officially record the number of something

<u>Sin</u>: an offense against religious or moral law; an action that is or is felt to be highly reprehensible; an often-serious shortcoming: FAULT; transgression of the law of God; a vitiated state of human nature in which the self is estranged from God

10. AMP: It does not rejoice at injustice,

MSG: Doesn't revel when others grovel,

Rejoice: to give joy to: GLADDEN; to feel joy or great delight

<u>Injustice</u>: absence of justice: violation of right or of the rights of another: UNFAIRNESS; an

unjust act: WRONG

Revel: to take part in a revel: CAROUSE; to take intense pleasure or satisfaction

Grovel: to give oneself over to what is base or unworthy: WALLOW

11. AMP: but rejoices with the truth [when right and truth prevail].

MSG: Takes pleasure in the flowering of truth,

Rejoice: to give joy to: GLADDEN; to feel joy or great delight

<u>Right</u>: RIGHTEOUS, UPRIGHT; being in accordance with what is just, good, or proper;

conforming to facts or truth: CORRECT

<u>Truth</u>: the body of real things, events, and facts: ACTUALITY; the state of being the case:

FACT; the state of being the case: FACT; a judgment, proposition, or idea that is true or

accepted as true,

<u>Prevail</u>: to gain ascendancy through strength or superiority: TRIUMPH; to be or become effective or effectual; to use persuasion successfully; to be frequent: PREDOMINATE; to be or continue in use or fashion: PERSIST

<u>Pleasure</u>: DESIRE, INCLINATION; a state of gratification; sensual gratification; frivolous amusement; a source of delight or joy

<u>Flowering</u>: an unfolding or development; a flourishing state or period of new development or growth

12. AMP: Love bears all things [regardless of what comes],

MSG: Puts up with anything,

Bears: to accept or allow oneself to be subjected to especially without giving way; to call for as suitable or essential; ASSUME, ACCEPT; to be equipped or furnished with (something); to give as testimony

13. AMP: believes all things [looking for the best in each one],

MSG: Trusts God always,

<u>Believes</u>: to consider to be true or honest; to accept the word or evidence of; to accept something as true, genuine, or real; to have a firm conviction as to the goodness, efficacy, or ability of something

Best: excelling all others; most productive of good: offering or producing the greatest advantage, utility, or satisfaction; the greatest degree of good or excellence; one's maximum effort

<u>Trust</u>: assured reliance on the character, ability, strength, or truth of someone or something; one in which confidence is placed; dependence on something future or contingent: HOPE; to rely on the truthfulness or accuracy of: BELIEVE; to place confidence in: rely on; to hope or expect confidently; to place confidence: DEPEND

Always: at all times: INVARIABLY; FOREVER; at any rate: in any event

14. AMP: hopes all things [remaining steadfast during difficult times],

MSG: Always looks for the best,

<u>Hope</u>: to cherish a desire with anticipation: to want something to happen or be true; TRUST; to desire with expectation of obtainment or fulfillment; to expect with confidence: TRUST; desire accompanied by expectation of or belief in fulfillment;

<u>Steadfast</u>: firmly fixed in place: IMMOVABLE; not subject to change; firm in belief, determination, or adherence: LOYAL

<u>Difficult</u>: hard to do, make, or carry out: ARDUOUS; hard to deal with, manage, or overcome; hard to understand: PUZZLING

<u>Best</u>: excelling all others; most productive of good: offering or producing the greatest advantage, utility, or satisfaction; the greatest degree of good or excellence; one's maximum effort

15. AMP: endures all things [without weakening].

MSG: Never looks back,

Endure: to continue in the same state; to remain firm under suffering or misfortune without yielding; to undergo especially without giving in

Weaken: to make weak: lessen the strength of; to reduce in intensity or effectiveness

<u>Never</u>: not ever: at no time; not in any degree: not under any condition

Look Back: to think about something in the past

16. AMP: Love never fails [it never fades nor ends]

MSG: But keeps going to the end.

<u>Never</u>: not ever: at no time; not in any degree: not under any condition

<u>Fails</u>: to lose strength: WEAKEN; to fade or die away; to stop functioning normally; to fall short; to be or become absent or inadequate; to be unsuccessful; to disappoint the expectations or trust of; to be deficient in: LACK; to leave undone: NEGLECT

<u>Fades</u>: to lose freshness, strength, or vitality: WITHER; to lose freshness or brilliance of color; to sink away: VANISH; to change gradually in loudness, strength, or visibility

Keeps Going: to continue moving forward; to continue doing something

<u>End</u>: a point that marks the extent of something; the point where something ceases to exist; DEATH, DESTRUCTION; an outcome worked toward: PURPOSE 17. AMP: And now there remain:

MSG: But for right now, until that completeness, we have three things to do to lead us toward that consummation:

Remain: to be a part not destroyed, taken, or used up; to be something yet to be shown, done, or treated; to stay in the same place or with the same person or group; to continue unchanged

Completeness: having all necessary parts, elements, or steps; TOTAL, ABSOLUTE; fully carried out: THOROUGH; brought to an end: CONCLUDED; to bring to an end and especially into a perfected state; to make whole or perfect; to mark the end of; EXECUTE, FULFILL; to carry out successfully

Consummation: the act of consummating; the ultimate end: FINISH

<u>Consummate</u>: extremely skilled and accomplished; of the highest degree; complete in every detail: PERFECT; complete in every detail: PERFECT; to make perfect;

ACHIEVE

18. AMP: faith [abiding trust in God and His promises],

MSG: Trust steadily in God

<u>Faith</u>: allegiance to duty or a person: LOYALTY; fidelity to one's promises; sincerity of intentions; belief and trust in and loyalty to God; firm belief in something for which there is no proof; complete trust; something that is believed especially with strong conviction

<u>Trust</u>: assured reliance on the character, ability, strength, or truth of someone or something; one in which confidence is placed; dependence on something future or contingent: HOPE; to

rely on the truthfulness or accuracy of: BELIEVE; to place confidence in: rely on; to hope or expect confidently; to place confidence: DEPEND

Abiding: continuing for a long time: ENDURING

<u>Promises</u>: a declaration that one will do or refrain from doing something specified; a legally binding declaration that gives the person to whom it is made a right to expect or to claim the performance or forbearance of a specified act; reason to expect something; to pledge to do, bring about, or provide

<u>Steadily</u>: direct or sure in movement: UNFALTERING; firm in position: FIXED; keeping nearly upright in a seaway; showing little variation or fluctuation: STABLE, UNIFORM; not easily disturbed or upset; constant in feeling, principle, purpose, or attachment

19. AMP: hope [confident expectation of eternal salvation],

MSG: hope unswervingly,

<u>Hope</u>: to cherish a desire with anticipation: to want something to happen or be true; TRUST; to desire with expectation of obtainment or fulfillment; to expect with confidence: TRUST; desire accompanied by expectation of or belief in fulfillment;

<u>Confident</u>: full of conviction; CEERTAIN; having or showing assurance and self-reliance <u>Expectation</u>: the act or state of expecting: ANTICIPATION;

Eternal: having infinite duration: EVERLASTING; of or relating to eternity; characterized by abiding fellowship with God; continued without intermission: PERPETUAL; seemingly endless; valid or existing at all times: TIMELESS

<u>Salvation</u>: deliverance from the power and effects of sin; liberation from ignorance or illusion; preservation from destruction or failure

<u>Unswervingly</u>: without swerving or turning aside; STEADILY, UNREMITTINGLY

20. AMP: love [unselfish love for others growing out of God's love for me],

MSG: love extravagantly.

Unselfish: not selfish: GENEROUS

<u>Extravagantly</u>: exceeding the limits of reason or necessity; lacking in moderation, balance, and restraint; extremely or excessively elaborate; extremely or unreasonably high in price
