- Enhance economic growth in our commercial corridor, attract businesses that benefit residents, enhance the tax base and push back on more apartments.
- Leverage my experience working with State, County and Federal entities to secure resources to preserve, protect and improve our community and parks.
- Create a system that allows for economic impact and fiscal analysis to reign in our growing liabilities and ensure we operate at a surplus with projects demonstrating long-term value for the community.
- Deliver clear communication among Council, Public Works, Police, community partners, residents and businesses.
