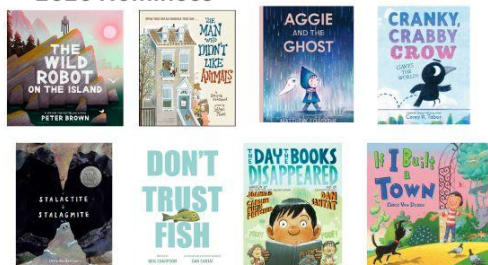
Please stay tuned for news about reading challenges, story walks, virtual author visits, book tastings and other fun library events!

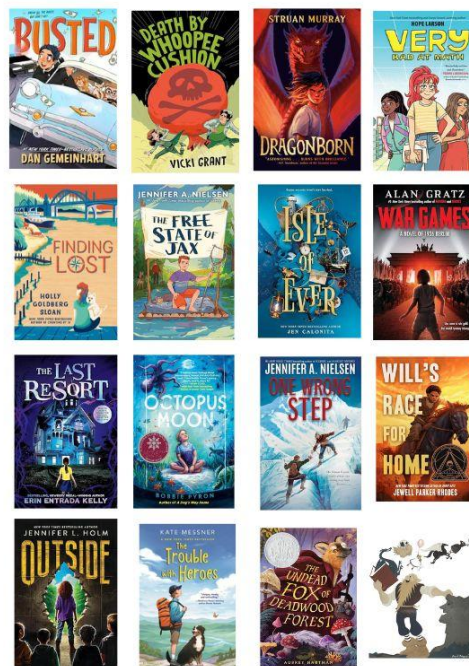
