Background

Gate City Charter School for the Arts opened to students in September of 2014. The vision of the school was to become a transformative leader in the education of students who will be prepared to successfully advance into the complex economy of the 21st century. The school began with multi-grade classrooms for 100 students grades K-6. In its 2nd year, it expanded to 160 students K-7. In its 3rd year 180 students K-8 with a single classroom for each grade level.

GCCSA was rechartered in March of 2020 for another 5 years by the NH Board of Education.

In 2023, GCCSA continues to be a small arts-integrated charter school. Our current enrollment is 170 students across grades K-8.
