## **Covid-Positive Test Results:**

Those receiving positive PCR and antigen test results should:

1. Quarantine for 7 days.

a. Covid-positive yet **asymptomatic** individuals seeking to return after 5-day isolation may do so only after a negative result on an antigen test. <u>Only asymptomatic and negative testing</u> <u>students will be allowed to return after 5 days.</u>

2. Isolate from household members where possible, including separate bathrooms.

**MOTION** (Sarah Thibeault/Neil Mahoney) Motion to accept the change to positive testing quarantine guidelines was accepted unanimously.

Masking guidelines-Discussion about the upcoming changing recommendations to optional masking. It was decided that the current policy would stand and would be revisited at the March BoT meeting. However, if in the next 4 weeks transmission is low and recommendations are made masks could become optional. Mrs. Bates will be available to help all students with emotional issues that may come up once masks become optional. Ms. Blanchette will send out an email to the community and offer office hours to discuss and ask questions.
