Changes to Covid-19 Policy-

Symptomatic students or staff can be allowed to return to school when one of the following two conditions is met:

- 1. Person receives an FDA-approved COVID-19 test that is negative, AND the person's symptoms are improving, and they are fever-free for at least 24 hours off any fever-reducing medications.
- a. Approved tests include: 1) A PCR-based molecular test. Antigen testing conducted within an appropriate number of days since symptom onset. 2) At-home tests. A list of approved home test kits can be found here.

Please note home test kits can only be used on an individual who is experiencing 1 or more symptoms of Covid-19. Per the directions, a symptomatic individual using home test kits should test twice if the first test results read negative. The second test should be completed at least 24 hours after the first at-home test.

When performing a home test follow the complete manufacturer's instructions. Write the name of the symptomatic individual on the test as well as the date and time of test. To submit test results to school, please take a picture in good lighting of results and email to rael@gccs-nh.org.

2. Person has met CDC criteria for ending of home isolation (i.e., if person is not tested, they are managed assuming they have COVID-19).

Covid-Positive Test Results:

Those receiving positive PCR and antigen test results should:

- 1. Quarantine for 10 days.
- a. Covid-positive yet **asymptomatic** individuals seeking to return after a 5-day isolation may do so only after a negative result on an antigen test. Only asymptomatic and negative testing students will be allowed to return after 5 days.
 - 2. Isolate from household members where possible, including separate bathrooms.

Household Member Quarantine and Isolation

- If someone is in quarantine and watching for symptoms/has symptoms, other household members do not need to quarantine unless the quarantined person has a positive test result.
- If someone is in isolation because they had a positive test result, everyone in the family not boostered and/or vaccinated should quarantine for 14 days after their last close contact with that person.
- If someone taking care of a person in isolation, cannot keep 6 feet between them or share a restroom, they should begin a 14-day quarantine when the person in their care is done with their 10-day isolation.
- Fully vaccinated and/or boostered people do not need to quarantine after contact with an infected person in their family.
- People who were infected with coronavirus within the previous 3 months, are recovered, and have no symptoms also do not need to quarantine after contact with an infected person in their household.
