#### **Songoro Partnership**

Scholarships for Secondary School

Songoro Scholarship Program is not only changing individual lives but is actually improving the standard of living in the entire region. Increased contributions by educated members of Songoro Lutheran Church have allowed the congregation to add elder care and occupational training programs in the community. Your support makes this happen.



Members of All Saints have supported 55 – 75 secondary school students per year ever since 2005 when our partnership began. This is done with funds contributed during All Saints scholarship appeal during the months of October – December.

As you are aware, Secondary education is not completely funded by the government in Tanzania and families are often unable to pay the fees required for their children to continue their education past the age of 12. A larger number of students attend secondary school in Songoro than most villages in the region. These students help to improve the lives of others in Songoro and help to teach other students. #### Scholarships for Higher Education


Individual patrons from All Saints have financially assisted additional worthy college students to help them receive their degrees this year. The number of college students that have been assisted by the Songoro/All Saints Scholarship Program is now 18 students. Many of these students have become community and church leaders, and have become substantial contributors at Songoro Lutheran Church.

A number of potential students are praying that we will find patrons for them. These include students that hope to receive their bachelor's degrees after 3 year programs that cost \$1500 - \$2500 per year.
