All Saints Lutheran Church Congregation,

As you are aware, we are in the midst of the MET (Mission Exploration Team) process which began with our initial meeting on October 4, 2022. The purpose of the MET process is to, as much as possible, look at where we are as a congregation at All Saints now, and where we, as a congregation, would like to go in the future to remain a vital ELCA congregation. The process is required by the ELCA to work through the Call Process as a method, as much as we can, to identify who we are so when we move to the call process of a new pastor for All Saints, we will be best able to identify candidates that will be best suited for what All Saints is now and what we want it to be in the future.

In January, we conducted focus groups with two identified groups to better understand what they are looking for in a church home. The two groups were for youth and young families, and new members. We continue to reach out to existing members for their input. We have a meeting on Thursday, January 19 to discuss the findings of the focus groups and begin the process of filling out the extensive documentation required for the ELCA. Once that is completed, we will then submit it to the Greater Milwaukee Synod and when it is found to be complete, we will then be able to actively enter the Call Process for a new pastor. Hopefully, by this summer, we will be at that point. There is no call committee at this point and when the time comes, the Church Council will look at names of people for the Call Committee and extend invitations to the individuals identified. I will make every effort to keep everyone as informed as possible, and if you have any thoughts or questions regarding the entire process, please contact me or any other members of the MET team.
