There will be a 2-3 minute video to watch, so we will have this Q & A presentation in our church sanctuary.

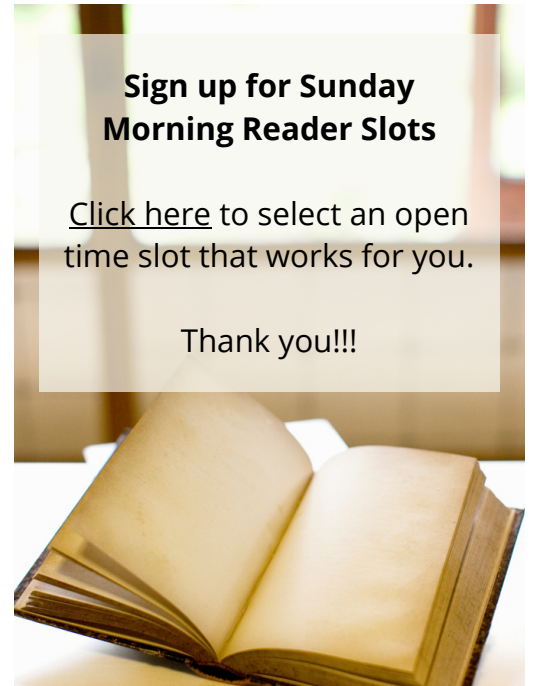
