I will be on sabbatical this summer and extend my wishes to you for a summer of health, growth in faith, and times of enjoying the gifts of this season.

Here are the steps to set up via the church Breeze account:



In your computer browser - Short version (details are below):

- 1. Log into https://allsaintswales.breezechms.com/login
- 2. Choose Give > Manage Recurring Giving > [+ New Gift] Alternative: https://aslcwales.org/give
- 3. Select Amount, Fund, Frequency, and Method. [Continue]
- 4. Provide credit/debit card of bank transfer information (or choose from previously entered information)
- 5. THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY

On your phone:

- 1. From your app store, install Breeze. It's the sailboat icon:
- 2. Contact the church office, <u>office@aslcwales.org</u>, for your Username, Password, or help logging in.
- 3. Open Breeze app with the sailboat
- 4. Choose button [Give Now]
- 5. Choose [Recurring Gifts] > [+ New Gift](You may have to scroll down)(You also can change previously set giving.)
- 6. Select Amount, Fund, Frequency, and Method. [Continue] (You may have to scroll down)
- 7. Provide credit/debit card of bank transfer information (or choose from previously entered information)
