Songoro – American Clinic has been operating for a number of years and is helping the residents of Songoro Village to avoid a 1.5 hour walk for needed medical care. Songoro Lutheran Church, the residents of Songoro Village, and All Saints, as the partner of Songoro Lutheran, have sponsored the construction of the clinic building and it is being staffed by the Songoro district government as agreed when the construction planning began.

The clinic opened in 2020 but was not fully equipped. A list of needed equipment was sent to All Saints, and the ASLC Human Concerns Committee conducted a successful appeal for the hospital beds that were needed. The beds are appreciated by the residents of Songoro and they are thankful to the All Saints members that contributed for them.

The list of needed equipment also included a number of medical examination and treatment items and it is hoped that All Saints contributions will help to supply these items to the clinic. Contribution envelopes are available at the display and you can choose to contribute to the equipment fund or for an individual item. 567 Contributor Strikes Again

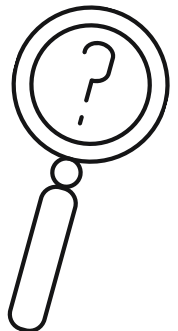
