We will continue to have someone at the Scrip table on Sundays throughout the month of August. However, we would ask that everyone plan ahead as both Kathy and Barb will be gone for vacations in August.

If anyone has any wants/needs for gift cards for the end of the summer, beginning of the fall for school needs, please contact Barb at the table or email her at bldras@wi.rr.com, or call/text her at 262-893-8616, **before July 31st to place an order**. The order will then arrive that week and would be at church for pick-up on August 7th. The next order might not be placed again until Labor Day Weekend. Please think about your upcoming needs—school supplies, last minute summer travel, get togethers at restaurants, etc.

Here are a few tips for last minute summer travel and into the fall:

- **Gas cards** - even those not local to Wisconsin
- Vacation photos - think **Shutterfly or Walgreens** when you order your pictures or make your photobooks
- **VISA cards** - no activation fee, so you can use them anytime
- **Office Depot/Max** for Back-to-School Supplies
- **Grocery cards** - for someone who attends school faraway
- **Bed, Bath & Beyond, Wayfair or Overstock.com** - for home updates or dorm/apartment needs
- All different kinds of **restaurants** are in stock and others can be ordered. Are you going to check out the new Olive Garden in Delafield—we have \$25 cards!
- And the old favorites—**Target, Wal-Mart, Kohl's** etc.

There is a list of all current gift cards available on the bulletin board by the Scrip table. There are many that might surprise you and the rebates average 4-8% for ASLC!

You can also order gift cards online at ShopatScrip.com. Please register a family account and use our ASLC enrollment code--**21E12A3876L8**. You will also need this code to set up an account on the RaiseRight app. There are some cards that are only available as e-cards and you would need to get the app to order and use those—like Airbnb or some airlines.

We have enjoyed wonderful support by our congregation and ask that you continue to buy Scrip cards! We want to continue making generous donations for missions in the future.
