Songoro residents no longer need to walk 1.5 hours to receive medical care. All Saints Human Concerns Committee has gathered funds for beds to be used in patient rooms but Songoro village members and the clinic physician are praying that funds for additional needed medical equipment will also arrive soon.

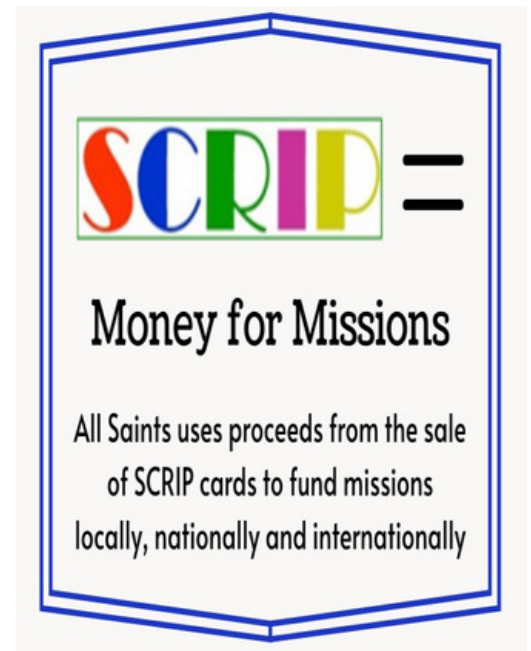
Your Human Concerns Committee
